With his NMSQT scores, each panticipating student will receive a handbook to help him evaluate his scores, compare his perfonmance with that of other high school students across the country, and give him information on choosing a college and financing his education. The handbook and other interpretive materials are furnished as a part of reporting the test results. <br> The highest-scoring students in each state will be named Semifinalists and will be eligible for Merit Scholarship consideration. In addition to the National Merit Scholarships financed by NMSC, more than 350 business corporations, foundations, colleges, professional associations, unions, trusts, other organizations. and individuals offer scholarships thru the Merit Program. <br> About 13,440 students have won Merit Scholarships in the 11 Merit Programs to date. Some 2330 Merit Scholarships were awarded in 1966 with stipends ranging from $\$ 100$ to $\$ 1,500$ per year for four college years.
