

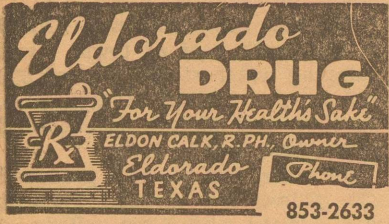

**Eaglette Mile Relay Team Placed Third In Recent State Meet**

The Eaglette Mile Relay team never finished lower than second place in that race until the state meet. At the state meet in Memorial Stadium the team finished 3rd behind Gruver and Amherst. The girls ran a 4:03.9 which is seven seconds better than their previous best effort which was at regional in Abilene.

This 4:03.9 time was good enough to rank them as the fifth fastest girls relay team in the state. This would include all the schools from class B to class 4A. During the season they won the Robert Lee meet, placed second behind Sanderson in the Eaglette and Wink meets, then won the Stephenville and District 8-B meets. The

team then ran a 4:10.5 in the finals at regional, won the mile relay at the Bluebonnet Bell Relays, and went on to run the 4:03.9 at state. Debbie Page, Rosellen Maness, Wally Joiner, and Gay Lynn Richardson were the team members with Gail Storie serving as alternate.
