PAT NEFF CANDIDATE FOR GOVERNOR SPEAKS SATURDAY.

Pat Neff, candidate for Governor, will speak at the Baptist Church Saturday morning at 9:30 o'clock, in the interest of his candidacy. Mr. Neff is a fine speaker, a christian gentleman, and the people should be out to hear him whether they are for or against him.

Mr. Neff is a native of the Lone Star State, and was reared on a farm near Waco. He is a lawyer by profession and has had 20 years of successful practice. Six years of the time he served as district attorney, trying 422 with conviction in all but 18.

While he served in this capacity he turned into the public treasury \$24,780 above his salary. He served as a member of the Texas legislature and was one of only three of the 164 members who during the entire session never missed a roll call and recorded a vote on every question submitted.

He is the youngest speaker that every presided over the Texas house of representative, the first from whose ruling there was never an appeal and the first one who was all ways present.

Mr. Neff made more than 100 speeches in advocacy of the various war activities during the recent war.

THE CABBAGE HARLEQUIN.

The cabbage Harlequin is one of the most destructive insects we have to deal with in the garden. They attack radishes mustard, turnips, cabbage and occasionally will attack English peas. These are a yellow bug with black spots on his back, and plants attacked by them look as if they had been burned.

As these insects belong to the sucking variety they cannot be reached with poison, and contact sprays which will kill the insect will damage the plant.

Prevention is the best remedy for them. They lay their eggs on Sunflowers and other weeds which grow in or near the garden. Therefore it will keep them materially reduced if you will keep your garden and surrounding lands clear of weeds and rubbish. When they attack the plants the best remedy is to catch them by hand and kill or burn them.

By planting radishes or turnips in the garden early in the season and burning them as soon as the bugs attack them or spraying with pure kerosene you can frequently get rid of them for the rest of the season. All old cabbage and turnips should be gathered and burned early in the fall, and thereby destroy their breeding places and eggs.

CALL FOR CITIZENS

RAILROAD MEETING.

The railroad committee asks that the citizens assemble in mass meeting at 2 o'clock next Tuesday, the 11th, at W. O. W. Hall to consider a proposition looking to the building of the road from San Angelo south. This is a matter that every man, woman and child in the county is interested in and it is the wish of the committee that there be a large attendance. The meeting will probably be addressed by some visitor who will outline the proposition immediately concerning us.

The following appeared in the Dallas News of May 4.

"Two hundred and nine thousand dollars has been allotted out of the Government's fund to the Orient Railroad, by the Interstate Commerce Commission, \$109,000 of the amount being appointed to the road in Texas. Amount made available by passage of the transportation act.

The necessity of the Orient requiring Government assistance both out of the Government's \$300,000,000 revolving fund, and in an increase in freight rates, was laid before the commission today by Representative Hudspeth, the understanding being that the commission would grant a hearing upon the road's application to borrow, both as to better equipping the existing main line, as well as the financing of the proposed extension from San Angelo to Del Rio."

The San Angelo Standard has been sold by A. G. Murphy to Houston Harte of Mo., Mr. Murphy retires from the field after 36 years of service in the news paper work, and leaves behind some staunch friends, and perhaps a few who are not pleased with every thing the Standard said. The editor of The Success has read the Standard constantly since its first issue in 1884. During the past decade we have not always agreed with the policy of friend Pat, but was glad to accord him the same privilege he has so generously accorded us.

We welcome Mr. Harte to the field and trust that (if he is from Missouri) we wont have to show him everything.

Of course the Orient Railroad has not given up the idea of building the Del Rio extension, they are very busy now, more so than the citizens of this county, so awake and be at the meeting next Tuesday.

The fuel situation for next winter is already attracting the attention of our citizens and they are getting busy now.

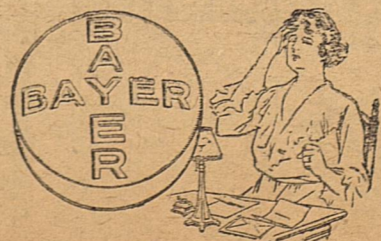

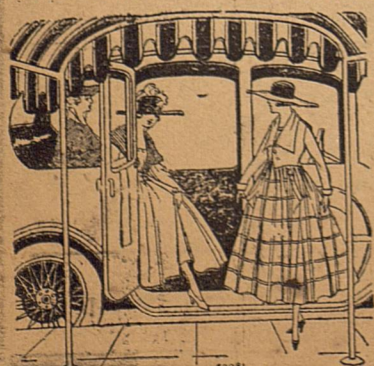

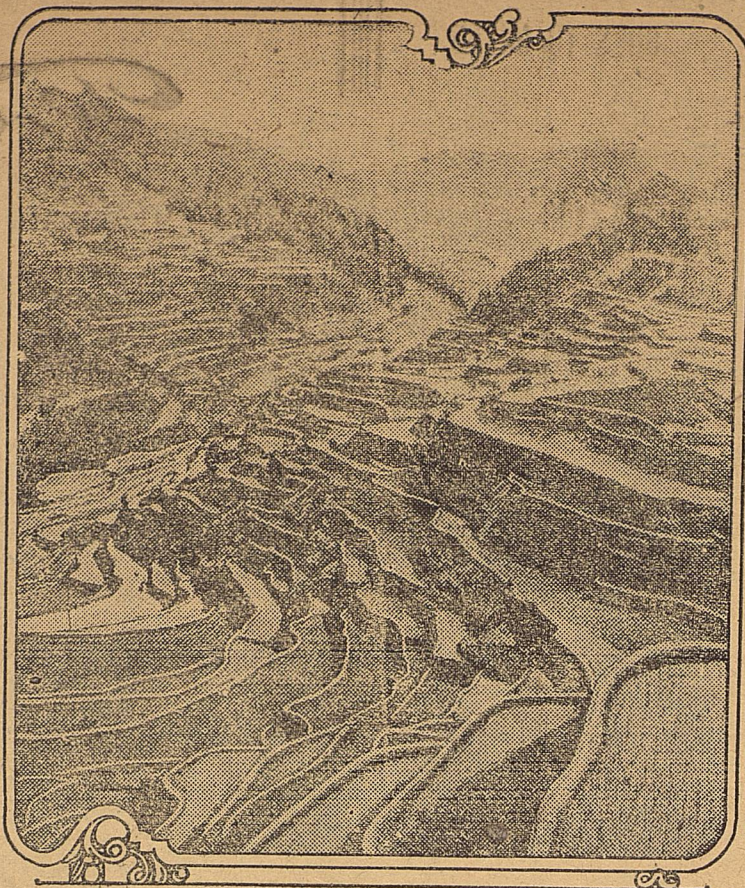

Rice Terraces Are World's Masterpieces



This is a photograph of the Ifugao Igorrot rice terraces, which are among the most remarkable of their kind in the world. They are one of the many marvelous sights for the tourist to see in the Philippine Islands and are to be found in the Ifugao district of the Mountain province, Northern Luzon.

The height of these terraces, which are held up by stone walls, is from 4 to 18 feet, averaging 8 feet high. It is estimated there are 12,121 miles of eight-foot stone walls in the Ifugao terraces, which is approximately half the distance around the world.

These terraces are skillfully irrigated by water brought in troughs along the precipitous mountain sides over long distances.

From misery to comfort and self-respect in five days' time, simply through the magic of an American ten dollar bill, is a transformation that is being wrought daily in Western Asia by the Near East Relief of 1 Madison Avenue, New York City. The group of five Armenian children shown in two pictures here have reason to bless the American donor of that ten dollar bill. With this money, the expert workers of Near East Relief in Armenia were able to rid the poor children of their loathsome rags and to clothe them with new garments of alaja cloth, woven in a Near East Relief Industrial plant and sewed into garments by the mother of the children. The mother was also paid a small fee for her services in making the garments.

This was a lucky family. There are thousands of others not so lucky in the Near East, simply because of a lack of other ten dollar bills. Near East Relief is asking the American people to contribute funds to save the starving in the Bible lands. It is estimated that over 1,250,000 adults are in desperate need, and 250,000 children are orphans and must be cared for. For the sum of \$180 a year Near East Relief can not only feed and clothe and shelter an orphan child, but can also give a course in education towards ultimate self-support and independence. Many of these orphans are being "adopted" by Americans, who are providing funds for the support of one or more over a given period.

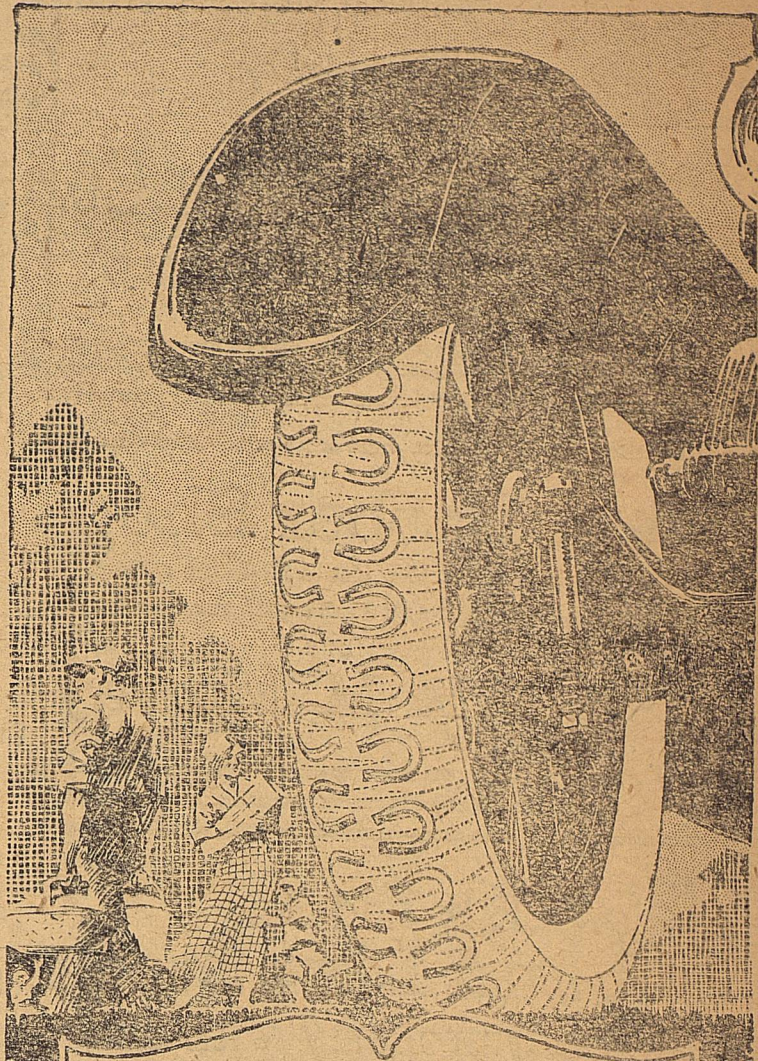

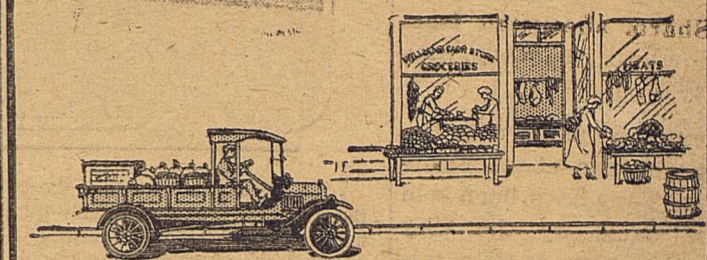
