W. O. W. RATES HELD LEGAL.
 The District Court of Otoe County, Nebraska, has held that the new rates put into effect on January 1, 1920 by the Sovereign Camp Woodmen of the World, was legally done and that the Head Camp was justifiable in the raise of rates.
 Many Woodmen have been waiting the outcome of this suit, the Eldorado Camp has as a unit failed to accept the new rate, consequently each policy carries a lien against it. This Camp has been unfortunate in the loss of two members by death since January 1. M. Davis who carried a \$2,000.00 policy was paid \$1,493.13, he joined the order in 1899, being a member 21 years was 47 when he joined and paid a rate of \$2.45 beside the Camp dues. Dr. C. R. Carver also had a \$2,000.00 policy and was paid \$1,506.55, he joined the order in 1899, being a member 21 years, joined at age of 42 and paid rate of \$1.95 cents besides the Camp dues.

We give the figures to show those who hold policies in the Order what they are actually worth in case of death.

Had M. Davis accepted the new rates they would have been \$13.48 per month.
 Had Dr. Carver accepted the new rate he would have had to pay \$10.54 per month.

 The Success joins the many friends of the bereaved in extending condolence in this their sad hour.



LIVE STOCK SANITARY COMMISSION OF TEXAS.

Fort Worth, Texas, August, 11, 1920. Circular No. 56. Quarantine. To Whom it May Concern:

Whereas, it has been determined by inspection by an authorized inspector of the Live Stock Sanitary Commission that the contagious disease, known as ANTHRAX exists among livestock in counties of Kimble and Menard in the State of Texas; and whereas, by reason of said infection the counties of Kimble and Menard were quarantined by order of the Live Stock Sanitary Commission.

And whereas, Schleicher County is apparently free of the contagious disease among live stock known as anthrax;

And whereas, it is deemed advisable to protect Schleicher county from infection from the hereinbefore mentioned quarantined counties the following order is hereby issued to take effect on and after date hereof:

It shall be unlawful for any cattle, horses, mules, asses, goats, sheep, or hogs to move or be moved from the said quarantined counties into Schleicher County, unless such live stock are accompanied by a permit or certificate issued by an authorized inspector of the Live Stock Sanitary Commission. All persons, companies and corporations are hereby forbidden to move any such live stock in violation of this order, and all owners and caretakers are hereby forbidden to permit the movement of such live stock in violation of this order.

This order shall be effective on and after the 11th day of August, A. D. 1920. Witness our hands at Fort Worth, Texas, this 11th day of August, A. D. 1920. Live Stock Sanitary Commission of Texas.

Joe Bailey's Record

Bailey Opposed the Democratic Administration. In a speech at Wichita Fall, March 30th, Bailey said: "Viewing the whole thing from top to bottom, not one single achievement of the entire Democratic Administration meets with my approval."

Bailey opposed a vigorous and patriotic prosecution of the war. Bailey said: "When war was declared I shut my mouth."

Bailey opposed the Federal Farm Loan Act.

Bailey opposed point blank in a speech at Wichita Falls, March 30th, to say how he stood on the open shop.

Bailey opposed the Federal Reserve Bank Law.

Bailey opposed the Child Labor Law.

Bailey opposed the pure food law.

Bailey opposed rural mail delivery.

Bailey opposed the Parcel Post Law that puts the man in the country in touch with the markets.

Bailey opposed the White Slave Act in the Caminetti case. This law prohibits the immoral act of transporting women for purposes of debauchery and prostitution. This statement is made as a reply to the charge that Neff was attorney for the defendant in the Patterson murder case.

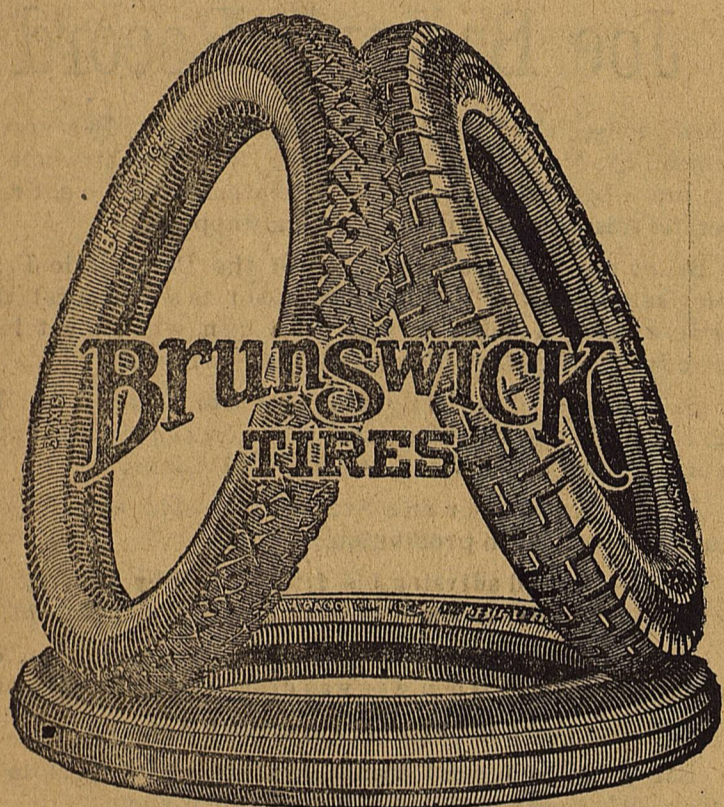
