### Joe Bailey's Record

Bailey opposed the Federal Reserve Bank Law.

Bailey opposed the Child Labor Law.

Bailey opposed the pure food law. Bailey opposed rural mail delivery

Bailey opposed the Parcle Post Law that puts the man in the country in tuch with the markets.

Bailey opposed the White Slave Act in the Caminetti case. This law prohibits the immoral act of transporting women for purposes of debauchery and prostitution. This statement is made as a reply to the charge that Neff was attorney for the defendant in the Patterson murder case.


