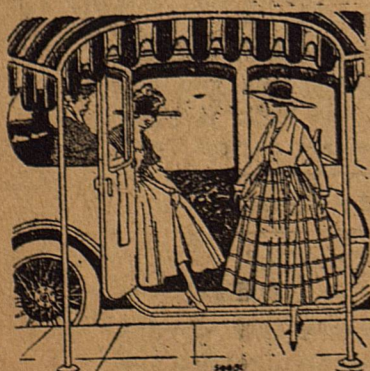

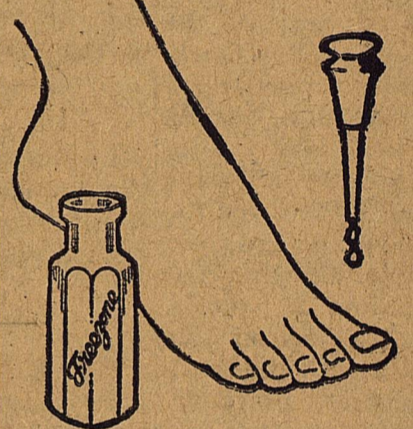
TO SERVE PIE.
