## SCHOOL REPORT.

The itenerant school nurse bas been with us tro weeks and has completed her inital visit with the exception of about four or five pupils who were absent las week. Her visit has been one o exceptional worth to us. This is a work that all good schools take under their own initiative but small sehools sush as our must depend upon the state de partment of health for this ser vice.
