TO PICKLE BEEF.

To every 200 pounds of meat take eight pounds of brown sugar and one-half ounce of saltpetre. To this amount of meat it generally takes about five gallons of brine. To make the brine take a wash boiler or outdoor kettle and put the water in the kettle with enough salt to bear up an egg. Then put in the sugar and saltpetre, stirring thoroughly until it is all well dissolved. Put on a slow fire so it get hot through, but should not be allowed to boil. The brine should be skimmed off the top, as all the impurities will rise to the surface, and after this is done the brine will be a light coffee color. Remove from the fire and let it get perfectly cold before pouring over the meat.

Get a tight barrel or cask that will not leak and waste the brine, as it is very important that the meat is well covered while in the brine. Pack the meat closely in the barrel and pour the brine over the meat and see that it has a good weight placed on it to keep it well covered.—Chas. D. Brown, in The Southland Farmer.

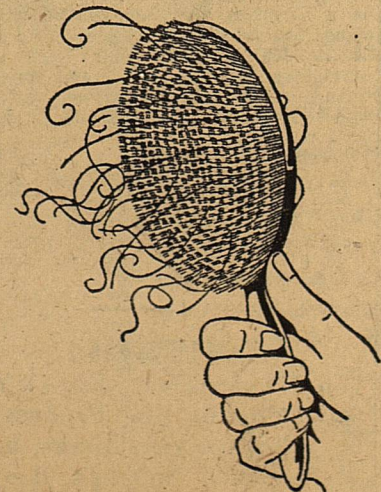

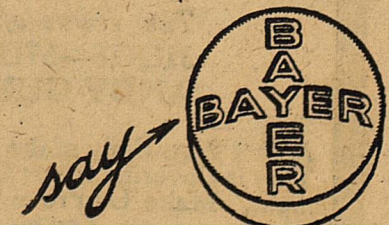
