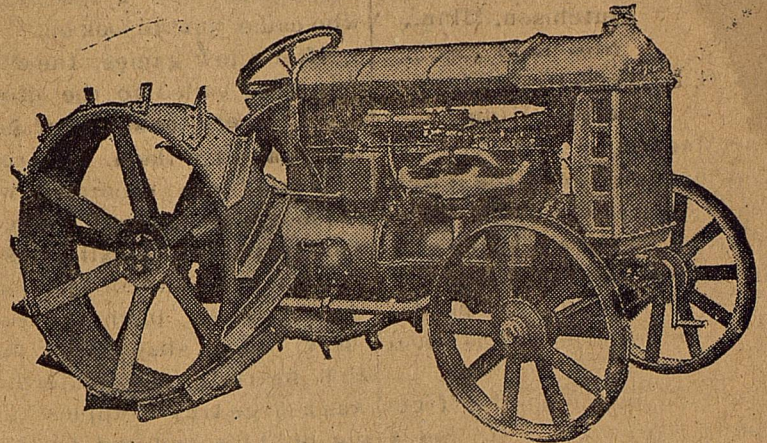

MORE DETAILS OF DEVIL'S APPEARANCE.

"The reporter finds much interest among readers of the Advance in the story of the presence of the Devil at a dance at Lake Marion, near Hutchinson. There are many people here from Silver Lake, which is near Hutchinson, who are acquainted with the locality and who are wondering what the stories mean. We had the following letter in the Bertha Herald, which may help clear up the mystery, and again it may not:

Dear Madam:
Your inquiry about the Hutchinson Devil came to hand and I am willing to tell all I know about it. Of course much that we hear about it is not dependable at all. What is fact is about it follows:

Lake Marion, nine miles from here, is a pretty resort, and a pavilion has been built there by the hotel for dancing.

On Sundays, for some time back, dances have been held there, and a large number of people from many miles around, who attend these affairs, have attended. It has been said these dances were discontinued that some of the dancers of both sexes got drunk; that the rooms at the hotel are all engaged in advance, and the cottages are broken into and the rooms occupied by the revellers.

On Sunday night, October 30, a dance was in progress. There were 100 dancers on the floor, when the Devil came and was in their midst. Some claim that he came up through the floor, others that he came down through the roof. He was the regular fellow, they say, horns, hoofs and tail. The light faded; the musical instruments flew from the hands of the players and were splintered. Curious light filled the place and the Devil danced among them. Women and girls screamed and fainted. One or more are still confined in bed with hysterics. They fled terror stricken from the place. Some hid in the woods all night. Others found shelter at farmhouses.

Twenty-six cars were left standing by the pavilion until daylight came and the party rallied and kept their courage up by keeping close together and got their cars away.

Many and varied stories are told about the details, but the above is generally told by all.

If it was a hoax it was cleverly done, and the perpetrators are keeping still. The proprietor has offered \$1,000 for an explanation of it. His place, hotel and all is deserted and abandoned. Neither he nor his family dare remain there.

If it was a real Devil, he has hurt his own business, for dancing among that class has ceased. It has been a real sensation, and I suppose, has been widely advertised. The hardest people to convince that it was a hoax are those who were there.

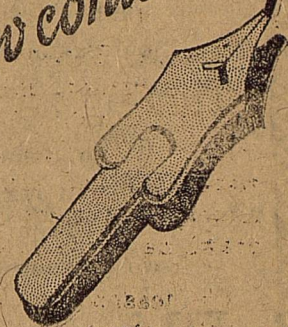
Dear Bro. Davis:

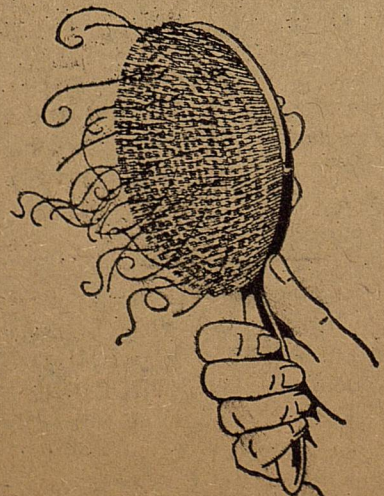

TO THE CITIZENS OF ELORADO.

Below I am giving to you a report of the physical conditions of pupils whom I examined first in November and have re-examined this week.

I find first eight cases of defective vision have been fitted with glasses; that eight cases of diseased tonsils have been removed; that all cases of scabies except three have been cured, these three being three that I recommended for treatment in November and have not yet perfected a cure; (these should receive immediate treatment anew at once or be isolated from school). That all cases of suspected trachoma have been cared for; forty pupils have had the advice of physician or dentist as to conditions I found abnormal.

The entire school shows a very marked improvement regarding cleanliness of teeth. Most all have tooth brushes and seem to be using them.

Of 76 undernourished children found in November, 66 have gained from 1 to 10 pounds. Four over children lost weight, but two have gained in weight. Four underweight children have made further losses.

The entire school seems impressed with the necessity of living up to some definite health rules. Children, even, give attention to diet. Parents have come to me in numbers of instances for aid and information concerning questions of child-welfare. With supervision each year by the state department of health, it is a matter of a very few years when the citizenship of Eldorado will unconsciously give a careful degree of attention to health laws.

These things that I have discussed thus briefly are unusual to a great degree for children and parents situated so far from socialists, and with no former attention given to physical inspection of children.

This is a new work in Texas and people are showing a great deal of interest in it, but other places are, as far as I can tell, behind this in personal attention to physical inspection.

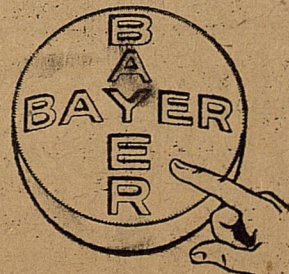
