

It is difficult, indeed, to secure evidence of the violations of the liquor laws. We attribute this to the fact that there is not sufficient co-operation of the good citizenship with the authorities. It is the duty of every good citizen to disclose every fact within his knowledge concerning law violations to the proper authorities. The bootlegger is a menace to life and moral wellbeing. In the first place, he disseminates poison, and in the second place, he corrupts the morals of the young boys. It is not an uncommon thing for boys from fifteen to eighteen years of age to become intoxicated on the poison sold and furnished by the bootleggers.

These boys are the future citizens of this country. The future safety of the government founded by our forefathers, depends upon the character to be developed by our boys. With the bootleggers to demoralize, our young men are handicapped in the effort to become useful citizens. Let us drive the bootlegger from Menard county. It is our duty to protect our boys.

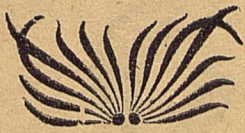

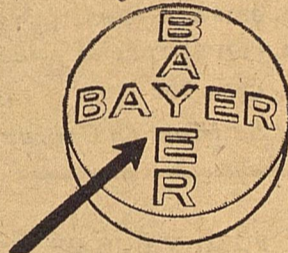
