Louis Hopkins is a son of F. M. Hopkins of Voca Texas, but has been residing in the Rudd neighborhood this county for 10 or 12 years, an employe on the S, C. Martin ranch, he has lived a peaceful life and was 36 years old Mr. Hopkins came to the Sheen ranch about the first of this year, Mrs. Sheen being a daughter of Mrs. Martin.

Upon learning of the death of Mr. Hopkins Sheriff Luedècke phoned the officers at San Ange lo to re-arrest Mr. Sheen which was dope and he was placed under a \$5,000 bond, the signers being Davis Sheen, L L. Farr and J. S. Allison.




