

PLATFORM DEMAND TO BE EXPLAINED

Texas Highway Association to Conduct Campaign of Education.

Waco, Tex. The Texas Highway Association, with headquarters here, is preparing to conduct a campaign of education between now and the reguar session of the Legislature to call attention to the full meaning of the lighway plank in the Democratic latform adopted at San Antonio. The platform declares in favor of

State system of highways but rec-gnizes that without Federal aid such system cannot be built. It then ac pts the provisions of the recent act Congress, "which declares that in he near future Federal co-operation n road building will be extended to hose States only that provide that he State, through a properly authorized and equipped agency shall mance from funds under the direct nd exclusive control of the State the enstruction, maintenance and operation of a State system of public aighways." The platform then adds The platform then adds

the following:
"We therefore recommend and urge upon the 38th Legislature the necessity for favorable action on all legislation, whether constitutional or statutory, that may be deemed requisite to enable the State to take over the construction, maintenance, com trol and operation of a system of public highways without prejudice

to the constitutional rights of the counties and of the State."

The Texas Highway Association calls attention to the fact that what this proposes is to give the State Covernment the authority to construct a State "system" and to maintain and operate that system. Under the Federal law such a "system" shall not exceed seven per cent of the total post road mileage of the State so far as Federal aid is concerned. In Texas this seven per cent system would embrace about 12,000 miles of highways, touching practically every county in the State. The authority it is proposed to give the State, ever to this system would not State over to this system would not interfere with the powers and juris diction of the counties over the remaining 93 per cent of the roads nor disturb any of their present revenues nor their powers of raising revenue

The Association points out that is necessary to pass such legislation in order to continue to receive Federal aid for highway construction in Texas, and it is necessary also if a State system of highways, such as is being constructed in other States is ever to be a realized fact in Texas

WILL TEXAS FORFEIT FEDERAL AID?

According to the Texas Highway Association. Texas receives five dol-lars from the Federal Government lars from the Federal Government for highway construction for every lollar which this State contributes n taxes to the Federal highway fund. The other four dollars are paid in my other States. Texas receives more Tederal aid for highways annually han any other State in the Union But this Federal aid is threatened he association points out, unless the aws of Texas are changed to con-orm to Federal regulations. The states that are paying the extra rederal taxes being spent in Texas have conformed. The asociation is arrying on a campaign to have the necessary changes made in our laws.

"The people cannot be expected to comprehend the highway situation nless somebody places the facts before them," says President Crawford in a statement just issued. "And placing such a question before the eople of a State the size of Texas a big job. That job can be per ormed only by means of organiza ion, and organization on a scale in keeping with the size of the job The Texas Highway Association has work and it has tackled it with no lusions as to its size. We know t is a big job, that it will take work .nd money to get the information to the people. And we know that t will require the co-operation of everybody who is alive to its importance. We need the co-operation of the newspapers, of chambers of commerce and other civic bodies, and most of all we need the co-operation of individual citizens who want o see Texas go forward and not backward. We want every such citizen to join the association.


