You are not allowed to kill more than aggregate of twentyfive in any one day of ducts, geese, brant, blackbellied and golden plovers, and yellowlegs, Wilson snipe or Jack snipe.

You must not buy, sell or bar ter any wild game or game birds.

You must not catch, kill or have in your possession nor ship at any one time more than the December. Limit three wild aggregate of seventy five ducks, geese, brant and birds.

You must not kill a turkey ben key in the following counties: at any time.

You must not kill any doe or spotted fawn at any time.

You must not catch, kil or have in your pogsession any wild song birds. You must not hunt any wild game or wild Fifteen quail and Mexican game birds at night with any pheasants (known as "Chacala- kind of light or lantein.






