

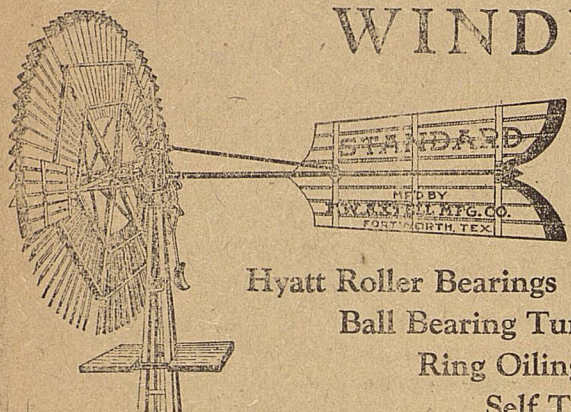

CHAMBER OF COMMERCE HAS SECOND MEETING.

Schleicher County Chamber of Commerce held its second meeting Saturday night and the organization was completed, the adoption of the Constitution and By-Laws and the paying of dues of 21 members, put the organization into actual operation.

The regular meeting nights will be the first Friday night in each month, the dues will be \$4.00 annually, payable quarterly, semi-annually or annually.

To become a member you must make application, and if accepted pay at least one quarter of the annual dues.

You cannot participate in the organization without becoming a member.

The Chamber of Commerce has already had a committee to meet Mr. Rust, owner and manager of the San Angelo Telephone Co., to make an urgent appeal for better telephone service in Schleicher County, the committee has already acted, (also a committee from the Woman's Club,) we have the promise of a better service with some much needed improvement within the next few months.

The purpose of this organization is to help the social and commercial interests of this county, we want better public buildings, better educational facilities, better stock, better and more farming, railroad, public camp ground and many other things too numerous to mention, so if you want to help in getting these things for Schleicher County join this organization and become a helper, the dues at present is only \$4.00 per year payable, quarterly, semi-annually or annually. If you do not see fit to join now, do not try to discourage any under taking the organization tackles. If you can't push don't set back.

The people of Eldorado and vicinity began Friday night to celebrate Armistice Day. They gathered at 7:00 o'clock at the Baptist Church where a patriotic rally was had, which pleased all who attended. This program was composed of songs and speeches fitted for the occasion.

The people who dance had a dance at the Bush-Smith Co. Garage Friday night and those in attendance report a real joyful time.

The Armistice Program Proper was staged Saturday morning gotten up by four of our lady teachers, Misses Annie Marie Doty, Lula Mae Evans, Eula and Grace Hardeman, and began at 10:45 with a parade by the school children, boy scouts and camp fire girls, the children were mostly of the smaller grades. A wagon drawn by two large black horses, with Uncle Sam, Columbus and Statute of Liberty represented on it, was near the front of the parade. Further back in the line was a wagon drawn by two large gray horses, with the grave of the unknown soldier represented on it, this float was guarded with four Boy Scouts on horseback, these were followed by the Camp Fire Girls.

Near the front of the parade Jona of Arc was represented, riding a blue gray pony.

The parade began at the school building and came to a halt on Main Street, where the program was rendered, the high gale made the rendering of the program difficult, but nevertheless it met the approval of the many bystanders and many congratulations were extended the four young ladies that got up the days patriotic program.

The flowers that were placed on the grave representing the unknown soldier's grave, were removed after the program and carried to the Cemetery and placed on the graves of the dead soldier boys that lie buried in our Cemetery.

All Hail! and a thousand cheers to Misses Doty, Hardeman, Evans and Hardeman, and the school children who took part, for the effort put forth to make November 11, a day of patriotism. The sight was worth seeing if you didn't hear anything.

The victory won by Mr. Mayfield, over the strongest financed opposition that ever confronted a Texas candidate, and with a united daily press against him, was the largest ever accorded any candidate, it shows that the average voter of Texas can not be influenced by the false propaganda that is broadcast over the land, the splendid character of Mr. Mayfield with the brilliancy of his personality, stood head and shoulders above the opposition, even to the bewilderment and astonishment of his friends. LOVE MAN ROBBS TWO, KILLS ONE; THREE ARRESTED

Canadian, Hemphill Co. Texas,
Nov. 12—While four men, Jim
Anderson, Hugh Howell, Daniel
Hernandez and Catarino Mar-
tinez, were coming home from
their work at the Santa Fe Rail-
road shops, early last Tuesday
morning, in an auto, a lone man
held up the party, took \$900
from Hernandez and Martinez
had shot and fatally wounded
Martinez, who, it is claimed,
tried to draw a gun.

The bandit then ordered Her-
nandez and Martinez, who was
dying, out of the car, entered
the car himself and told Ander-
son and Howell to drive on.

Later the car was found, with
the seat coverings, which had
been saturated with blood, bur-
ned.

Hernandez, in the meantime,
notified the Santa Fe officials,
who, in turn, notified the Sheriff.
Martinez did not regain con-
sciousness and died at 8 o'clock
Tuesday morning.

On Thursday evening Jim
Anderson, Hugh Howell and
Norvel Giddens, Howell's broth-
er-in-law, were arrested in con-
nection with the robbery and
killing.—Dallas News.

Jim Anderson, who is impli-
cated in the above trouble, at
one time lived at Eldorado with
his parents, Mr and Mrs. Ben
Anderson, and who are now vis-
iting here, and his friends here
trusts that he will have no trou-
ble vindicating himself.

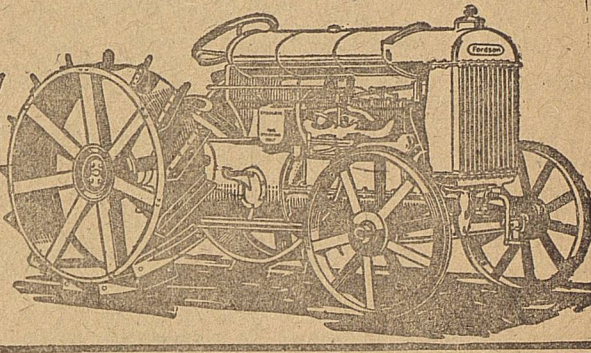

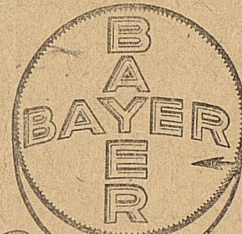
