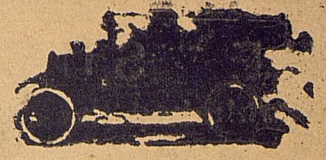

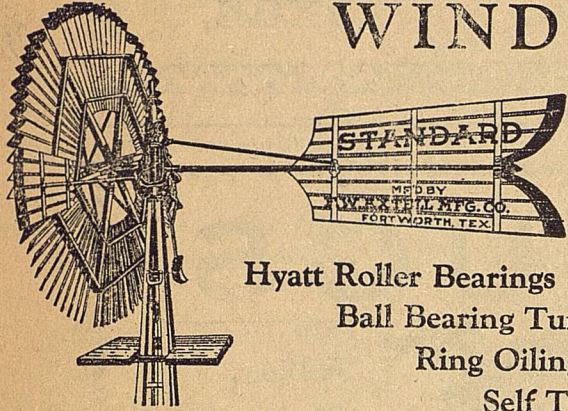

### KU KLUX AND KNIGHT OF COLUMBUS OATHS.

Below is given the oath of the Ku Klux Klan and oath of Knights of Columbus, as recorded in the Congressional Record at Washington, and published in Colneel Mayfield's Weekly, and furnished The Success by Mr. L. H. Fletcher who pays for its publication.

#### THE K. K. OATH.

"As klansmen, we have no fight with anyone that has this country's interest at heart. We prefer to live in harmony with all men and would work with them to keep this country the greatest and the most wonderful country in the world, where every man can work his way up the ladder of success and live a life of complete happiness and harmony, always remembering those sublime words, 'Peace on earth, good will to all men.'"

#### Oath of Allegiance.

(You will say) "I—(pronounce your full name—and repeat after me) most solemnly pledge, promise and swear, that I will never slander, defraud, or in any manner wrong, the Knights of the Ku Klux Klan, a Klansman, or a Klansman's family, nor will I suffer the same to be done, if I can prevent it.

"I swear that I will be faithful, in defending and protecting the home, reputation, and physical and business interests, of a Klansman, and that of Klansman's family.

"I swear that I will at any time, without hesitating, go to the assistance or rescue, of a Klansman in any way, at his call I will answer, I will be truly klandish toward Klansmen, in all things honorable.

"I swear to keep secure to myself, a secret of a Klansman when same is committed to me, in the sacred bond of klansmanship the crime of violating this solemn oath—treason against the United States of America, rape, and malicious murder excepted.

Thou my witness, Almighty God, Amen."

## KU KLUX AND KNIGHT OF COLUMBUS OATHS

(Continued from page one.)

Paul, and all the saints, sacred host of Heavens, and to you, my Ghostly Father, the superior general of the Society of Jesus, founded by St. Ignatius Loyola, in the pontification of Paul the III, and continued to the present, do by the womb of the Virgin the matrix of God, and the rod of Jesus Christ, declare and swear that His Holiness, the Pope, is Christ's vice-regent and is the true and only head of the Catholic or Universal Church throughout the earth; and that by virtue of the keys of binding and loosing given His Holiness by my Savior, Jesus Christ, he has power to depose heretical kings, princes, states, commonwealths, and governments and they may be safely destroyed. Therefore to the utmost of my power I will defend this doctrine and His Holiness' right and custom against all usurpers of the heretical or Protestant authority whatever, especially the Lutheran Church of Germany, Holland, Denmark, Sweden and Norway, and the now pretended authority and Churches of England and Scotland, and the branches of same now established in Ireland and on the Continent of America and elsewhere, and all adherents in regard that they may be usurped and heretical opposing the sacred Mother Church of Rome.

"I do now denounce and disown any allegiance as due to any heretical king, prince, or state, named Protestant of Liberals, or obedience to any of their laws, magistrates, or officers.

"I do further declare that the doctrine of the Churches of England and Scotland, of the Calvinists, Hugenots, and other of the name of Protestants or Masons to be damnable, and they themselves to be damned who will not forsake the same.

"I do further declare that I will help, assist, and advise all any of His Holiness' agents, in any place where I should be, in Switzerlan, Germany, Holland, Ireland, or America, or in any other kingdom or territory I shall come to, and do my utmost to extirpate the heretical Protestants or Masonic doctrines and to destroy all their pretended powers, legal or other wise.

"I do further promise and declare that, notwithstanding that I am dispensed with to assume any religion heretical for the propagation of the Mother Church's interest, to keep secret and private all her agent's counsels from time to time, as they intrust me, and not divulge, directly or indirectly, by word, written, or circumstances whatever, but to execute all that should be proposed, given in charge, or discovered unto me by you, my Ghostly Father, or any of this sacred order.

"I do further promise and declare that I will have no opinion or will of my own or any mental

reservation whatsoever, even as a corpse or cadaver (perineae cadaver), but will unhesitatingly obey each and every command that I may receive from my superiors in the militia of the Pope and Jesus Christ.

"That I will go to any part of the world whithersoever I may be sent, to the frozen regions north, jungles of India, to the centers of civilization of Europe, or to the wild haunts of the barbarous savages of America without murmuring or repining, and will be submissive in all things whatsoever is communicated to me.

"I do further promise and declare that I will, when opportunity presents, make and wage relentless war, secretly and openly, against all heretics, Protestants and Masons, as I am directed to do, to extirpate them from the face of the earth; and that I will spare neither age, sex, or condition, and that I will hang, burn, waste, boil, flay, strangle, and bury alive these infamous heretics; rip up the stomachs and wombs of their women, and crush their infants' heads against the walls in order to annihilate their execrable race. That when the same can not be done openly, I will secretly use the poisonous cup, the strangulation cord, the steel of the poniard, or the leaden bullet, regardless of the honor, rank, dignity, or authority of the persons, whatever may be their condition in life, either public or private, as I at any time may be directed so to do by any agents of the Pope or superior of the Brotherhood of the Holy Father of the Society of Jesus,

"In confirmation of which I hereby dedicate my life, soul, and all corporal powers, and with the dagger which I now receive I will subscribe, my name written in my blood in testimony thereof; and should I prove false or weaken in my determination, may my brethren and fellow soldiers of the militia of the Pope cut off my hands and feet and my throat from ear to ear, my belly be opened and sulphur burned therein with all the punishment that can be inflicted upon me on earth and my soul shall be tortured by demons in eternal hell forever.

"That I will in voting always vote for a K. of C. in preference to a Protestant, especially a Mason, and that I will leave my party so to do; that if two Catholics are on the ticket I will satisfy myself which is the better support of the Mother Church and vote accordingly.

"That I will not deal with or employ a Protestant if in my power to deal with or employ a Catholic. That I will place Catholic girls in Protestant families that a weekly report may be made of the inner movements of the heretics.

"That I will provide myself with arms and ammunition that I may be in readiness when the word is passed, or I am commanded to defend the church either as an individual or with

## Why Freight Rates Cannot Be Reduced

### Railroads Under Public Control

#### Transportation Charges Must Stay Up Until Costs Come Down, President Storey of the Santa Fe Explains

United States Senator Capper, through his various publications, has been demanding a reduction of freight rates; but his attitude on the general subject of railroads has not blinded him to the main facts about government control, which have been clearly presented in the following editorial from one of his papers, the Topeka Daily Capital:

"The railroad cannot fix its own rates and charges.

"It cannot name the wages it will pay.

"It cannot enter into combinations and deals.

"It cannot shut down when business goes to the bad.

"It cannot buy or sell a railroad system.

"It cannot make capitalistic profits and dividends.

"It cannot even determine how much capital it shall issue on its property, or issue any without previous approval of the public.

"It is, in fact, an agency of the public, controlled completely by the government."

The fact is, rates cannot be reduced unless costs are reduced. Costs cannot be reduced so long as the present scale of wages and the prices of fuel, materials and other supplies are maintained, and in these matters the hands of the Santa Fe are tied.

What is particularly needed at this time is better transportation service, more cars, locomotives, and other facilities necessary for moving the business, and the Santa Fe is doing everything in its power to provide these.

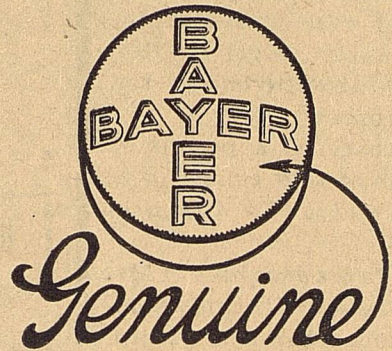
## METHODIST HOLD FIRST QUARTELY CONFERENCE
