| EXTENSION OF SANTA FE RAILROAD SYSTEM. <br> Vice President and Gener Manhger $F$. G. Peltibone of the Santa Fe returnel to beadquarte last waek after a several week absence in the Bast. He came b way of Benumont and the Gu Luters ate into Galveston, trave ing on a -pecial train. Mr, $\mathrm{P}_{\mathrm{e}}$ tibone spent sinme time in Chicag conferring with the bigher offcial of the system on matters pertaid ing to the Guif syatem, with spec lat reference to the exteutions i West Texas now in course of con struction and contemplated. <br> Discussing operations in th western section of the state, wher the sauta Fe is especiafly activ in extending its lines, he sai there was little to add to what ha already been published about ta worls uuder way out there While he did not say in so man words, he intimated that exten sions to the westward had onl vegun ald that it is yet too eari to take the public into confidenc and announce the future plans the company. <br> He said there is now a propo sition betore the people of Sa Angeio for the extension of th Lampasas branch from its west ern terminus at San Angelo sout ward to the southern border of Tom green county. It is quit likely this extension will be made In railroad circles it is believe that his extension will be mad beyond Tom Green county aud that the road will be built to El dorado in Schlercher county, al musi due south from San Augilo The other extensions which ha | been decided upon is to extend the line from the Lampasas branich westward at Limeta, or some - 0 her point in that vicinity, via San Saba to Brady, which is the eouthen terminus of the Frisco. <br> It is believed that the extension will not stop at Brady, but will later be extended westward by south to Eldo ado, and that evenlually the Santa Fe will penetrat. anothȩr section of virgin countr. southwestwardly to the Mesican border. <br> It bas not been difinitely decided whether the westera extensiou to Brady will be made from Lometa or some other point nearby, Al depending upon the engineers. <br> The preliminary survegs have been run and the surveying expedition is now running its locating lines to determine where the extension will tap the Lampasas branch. <br> Aud it seems to this writer that it wou ld be a wise idea to induce the manegement of the Santa Fe to come on a little futher west and take note of the immense advantages that would accrue to that road to come right on to Ozona. From Lometa to San Saba thence to Brads, thence to Meuardvill, thence to Eldorado and on to Ozono would make a railroad that could consistently ba named "Ihe air Line." - Ozona Kicker. Ot course we as Eldoradoans wo uld be pleased to see the Santa Fe make its terminus from both ways here, but we know of know other town in West Cexas than the beautiful, virtuous and freeist from all orime Ozona we had rather be connected with by railroad faclities |
