cover part of actual production losses resulting from the Drought \& Storm damage.
Farmers may be eligible for loans of up to 80 percent of their actual losses or the operating loan needed to continue in business or $\$ 500,000$ whichever is less. Farmers mus e unable eligible. The interest is to be percent on Emergency Loans. Alsu Farmer must has

of production to be eligible for
an FmHA emergency loan. Farmers participating in the PIK or Federal Crop Insurance program will have to figure in from those programs in determining their loss.

Applications for loans under this emergency designation will be accepted until 6-17-91 but farmers should apply as soon as possible. Delays in applying cold create backlogs in processing and possibly over into the new farming season.

FmHA is a credit agency of the U.S. Department of Agriculture. It is authorized to provide disaster emergency loans to recognized farmers who work at and rely on farming for a
