## Catholic Church Dedicates New Building

The parishioners at Our Lady of Guadalupe in Eldorado have new classrooms and a parish hall after many months of planning and construction. Most Reverend Michael D. Pfeifer, O.M.I., Bishop of the Diocese of San Angelo blessed the building on December 11, 1991 following a mass of dedication of the new facility. After the mass a meal was served for the parishioners and guests in attendance.

Financing of the new building was assisted with a grant from the Catholic Church Extension Society, by donations from the parishioners and with a loan. Construction was done by Louis Blanek Construction out of San Angelo. Within the building are five classrooms for religious education of the children of the parish and a

gathering place or open hall area for events held at the parish.

Father Jeremiah McCarthy, M.S.C., pastor, said the people of his church have worked hard to bring about the new building and are looking forward to using it. The new classrooms are sorely needed since the old ones are too small and in need of remodeling. Also the parish is experiencing growth with more families and youngsters attending church and religion classes so the new building is needed now. Father McCarthy expressed his gratitude and the gratitude of the parishioners to the Catholic Church Extension Society for the assistance of the construction grant without which this project would not have been possible.

The Eldorado 8th Grade Girls played Junction in the Wall Tournament on Thursday, December 12th. The final score was Eldorado-29 and Junction-15.

"After a slow start, the Eldorado girls found the basket. Tara Whitten led the Eagles with 17 points and numerous rebounds. She was followed by Estella Montalvo and Erin Meador, each with six points. The girls were pretty upset because Junction was extremely physical, but the eighth graders got tough and did a good job," stated Coach Teresa Baker.

The girls returned to the Wall Tournament on Saturday, December 14th to play Eden.

"Once again the Eagles played a good game against Eden, commented coach Teresa Baker.

Tara Whitten led the girls in scoring with 17 points, and in rebounding. She was followed by Leslie Hunter with 5, Tara Hunley and Erin Meador, each with 4, and Jamie Hardy and Estella Montalvo, each with 2 points. This win set

the team to play the Chamioship against the Wall Hawks. The final score was Eldorado-36 and Eden-19.

The girls lost the game against Wall, 30-20, which placed them 2nd in the tournament.

"We didn't play as well as we should have. The girls had been beaten by Wall as 7th Graders and we seemed to have some mental blocks about Wall. We let Wall run their game instead of playing our game," said Coach Baker. "We'll see Wall at least 3 more times this year, and I feel sure we will play much better in the future."

The next game for the 8th Grade Girls was on Monday, December 16th, against Iraan.

"Even though it wasn't a high scoring game, the girls ran their offenses and their zone press well against the Iraan Braves. Out of 12 girls playing, 7 scored," commented Coach Baker. "When we return from the holidays, we face Ozona at Eldorado, on January 6th at 6:00 p.m., and it will be a tough battle."

## NOTICE OF CHANGES TO ELECTION PRECINCT BOUNDARIES

STATE OF TEXAS

COUNTY OF SCHLEICHER

On this 20th day of November, 1991, the Schleicher County Commissioners' Court ordered certain changes to the County Election Precincts pursuant to Chapter 42 of the Texas Election Code, such changes to become effective on January 1, 1992. The changes were necessitated in order to conform election precinct boundaries with the County Commissioner precinct boundaries adopted by the County Commissioners' Court on November 20, 1991. As amended, those election precincts affected are: Election Precinct 1 was modified along U.S. Highway 277 south af Eldorado. Election Precinct No. 2 was modified east of Eldorado along U.S. Highway 190 and extended north of U.S. 190 to the county line in the northeastern area of the County. Election Precinct No. 3 was modified to delete the northeastern area of the county. Each of the four Election Precincts were modified within the City of Eldorado and as required to conform to newly adopted County Commissioner Precincts. Additional information concerning these changes is available in the Schleicher County Judge's office, Schleicher County Courthouse.

Schleicher County has submitted its redistricting plan adopted November 20, 1991 (Commissioner, Justice of the Peace and Constable and election), to the United States Department of Justice for its review under Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act, 42 USC § 1973c. 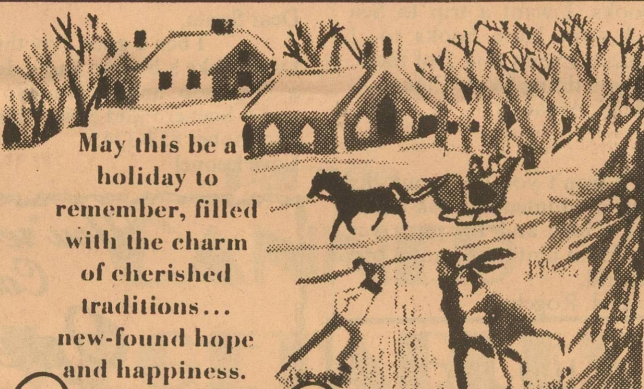

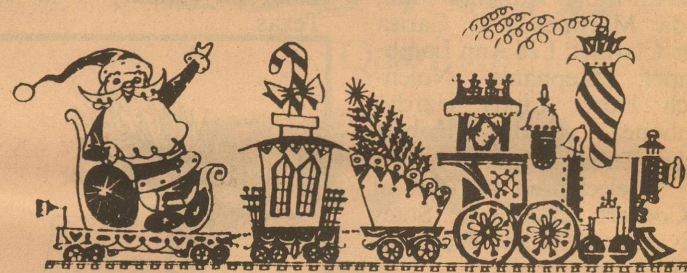

3. Income Guideline stipulations.
4. Liquid resources assets cannot exceed \$1000. The equity value of a car greater than \$1500 is counted against the \$1000 limit. Personal property and homestead are exempt assets.
5. Eligible persons must be a resident of Schleicher County.
6. Applicants must provide all requested information and documentation requested or applications will be denied.
7. Applicants have the right to appeal adverse decisions.

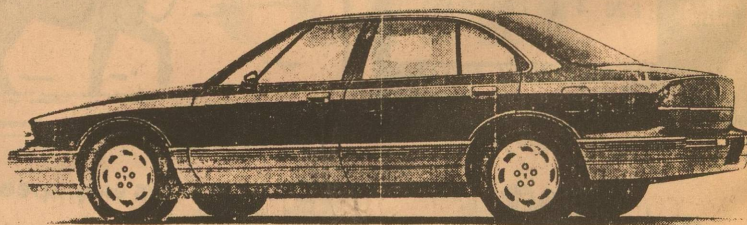
