Property Tax Protest and Appeal Procedures

The law gives property owners the right to protest
actions concerning their property tax appraisals. You may follow these appeal procedures if you have a
concern about:

## the value placed on your property

* any exemptions that may apply to you
* the taxable status of your property
the local governmenty
taxing your property
* any action taken by the
adversely affected you.


## Informal Review

Taxpayers are encouraged to make an appointmen with the appraiser to discuss their property value. They should bring information to substantiate
they feel that their property value is incorrect.

Review by the Appraisal Review Board If you can't tesolve your problem informally with the appraisal district staff, you may have your case heard by the appraisal review board (ARB).
The ARB is an independent board of citizens that reviews problems with appraisals or other concerns
listed above. It has the power to order the appraisal district to make the newessary changes to solve
problems. If you file a written request for an problems. If you file a written request for an ARB
hearing (called a notice of protest) before the deadline, the ARB will set your case for a hearing. You'll receive written notice of the time, date and place of the hearing. The hearing will be informal.

asked to present evidence about your case.

You can get a copy of the protest form from your
local appraisal district office at 101 West Warner Avenue.
The law requires ARB members to sign an affidavil saying hat hey haven't talked abut your case befor

Review by the District Court
After it decides to hear your case, the ARB must send you a copy of its order by certified mail. If you're no satisfied with the decision, you have the right to you must start the process by filing a petition within 45 days of the date you receive the ARB's order. I the appraisal district has appraised your property a
$\$ 1,000,000$ or more, you must file a notice of appeal $\$ 1,000,000$ or more, you must file a notice of appeal
with the chief appraiser within 15 days of the date ou receive the ARB's order.

Late protests are due the day before the appraisa review board approves records for the yea Contact your appraisal district for more info mation.

Special Deadlines
For change of use (the appraisal district informed you that you are losing agricultural appraisa deadline is before the 30th day after the notice of the determination was mailed to you.

For ARB changes (the ARB has informed you or a change that increases your lax liability and the change didn' tresulf from a protest you filed), the deadline is before the 30 th day after the notice of - 20

If you believe the appraisal district or ARB should have sent you a notice and did not, you may file a protest until the day before taxes ARB decides whether it will hear your case based on evidence about whether a required notice was mailed to you. The deadine is postponed to the nexi busi-
ness day if if falls on a weekend or holiday.
