## Speak Out Eldorado

A Licensed Group Day Care Home is considered a many state requirements that must be met:

1. As a director of a Licensed Group Day Care Home, we are required to participate yearly in at least 20 hours of child care training.

Our homes must have an annual fire inspection with a written report by the local Fire Marshal.

The gas pipes must 1 annually for leaks. annual sanitation inspection with a written report by a sanitation official.
5. We must be certified in CPR and first aid annually. We receive a minimum of wo unannounced visits Rem the State Licensing Representative each year. At Day end of each visit another Day Care Compliance
Record is filled out Record is filled out and placed in the facilities file
with the state. We also receive at least four unannounced visits from the USDA Nutrition Program to check compliances with thei
rules. We are required to no paid vacations, no paid serve breakfast, lunch, sick leave, and no retirement. morning and afternoon We make $\$ 290.00$ a month to snacks, and supper if the pay our medical bills, children are at our homes insurance, car payments and
during the evening. These meals and snacks are based (i.e. clothes, medications on the four food groups and etc.). We were making $\$ .80$ in amounts sufficient to meet per hour eight years ago and the nutritional needs of each today we are making $\$ 1.00$ child. We do not serve junk per hour. food or foods high in sugar and salt content.

A minimum of $65 \%$ of
our income is spent on food, paper goods, cleaning
supplies,
utilities, maintenance crafts, repair, toys, activities, gifis, rewards, licensing fees, CPR and first licensing fees, CPR and first
aid certification and 20 hours aid certification and 20 hours
of child care development education. Then $30 \%$ to $35 \%$ of the protit is paid to "Uncle Sam". For example: 6 children at $\$ 50$ per week is $\$ 1,200.00$ income per month, less $65 \%$ of expenses incurred ( $-\$ 780.00$ ) is a net income of $\$ 420.00$. Taking $\$ 126.00$ for FICA income tax out of the net income leaves a
monthly income of $\$ 294.00$.

The Child Care Association has informed us that the Texas Department of Protective and Regulatory Services (PRS) is currently considering standards for child standards for child care facilities. Lower staff to child
ratios, lower square footage additional staff in vehicles transporting school age children, and lower field age ratios will definitely raise the cost of child care to the parent or entity paying the bill. The inerease in cost will range from $20 \% \quad 10 \quad 50 \%$ depending upon individual facility circumstances.
