





There are two dishes which are regarded with more favor by Miss Fos-ter, than are any others. These are Bronk shrimps and chicken en casserole. She uses the simplest of formulas but insists upon the purest of ingredients, using pure butter, and evap orated milk. The recipes that she uses are:

Bronk Shrimps. 2 cups shrimps, canned or fresh 4 tbsp. fat ½ tsp. salt Few grains cay-Yolks 2 eggs ½ cup evaporated milk ½ cup water 1 tbsp. flour

grains cay-2 tsp. lemon juice Clean the shrimps, and cook in haif the fat for 2 minutes; add seasoning and lemon; cook 2 minutes longer. Re move shrimps and make a white sauce of the remaining fat, flour and milk; when thickened add yolks of eggs slightly beaten, stirring in quickly and cooking two minutes; add the shrimps.

Chicken en Casserole. tender chicken 1 cup evaporated for roasting milk 1 tbsp. chopped parsley 2 cups chopped mushrooms tbsp. butter tbsp. lard

Salt and pepper 2 cups chopped pint hot water mushrooms Clean chicken, split down back, and lay breast upward in casserole. Spread fat over breast, dust with salt and pepper, add hot water, cover closely and cook in hot oven one hour. nearly tender put in evaporated milk rushrooms and parsley. Cover again, and cook 20 minutes longer. hot in casserole.

Judgment has been rendered by the Travis County District Court for the State of Texas forfeiting the charter and terminating the corporate existence of the Red Ball Stage Lines of Greenville.

The Farmers' Fund of Texas, cap ital stock \$100,000, with principal office in Dallas, has been granted a charter. The corporation is organized for the purpose of accumulating and loaning money, but it shall not exercise banking or discounting priv-

No objection has been made to the State Board of Water Engineers for permit to use water from the Guadalupe River above Kerrville for the new state fish hatchery. The board announced that the permit would be issued after a formal hearing which is required by law.

Air mail service for Austin is probability of the near future George H. Sparenberg, postmaster, announced after a conference with postal officials who are surveying an air mail route from San Antonio to Chicago, via Austin, Dallas, and Kansas City.

Contracts for approximately \$60,000 worth of road-building machinery for the State Highway Commission will be awarded by the Board o Control at their next meeting. The machinery is to be used in ninety eight West Texas counties under the supervision of Joe Burkett, High way Commissioner.

Eighteen bids have been opened by the Board of Control to furnish \$60, 000 worth of furniture and equipment to Texas Technological College now being constructed at Lubbock. Most of it is special laboratory equip ment, but included are 826 table arm chairs and 340 opera chairs.

Right of a municipality to restrain a person of her liberty for permit ting chickens to run at large is at tacked in the application of Mrs. W W. Graham of Matador, Motley county, for writ of habeas corpus filed in the Court of Criminal Ap peals.

In order to prevent confusion among Texas motorists, stress should be laid upon the fact that while the new automobile headlight law be came effective June 18, yet the individual motorist does not have to comply with the law until Sept. 1. announces Reed Granbury, director of the headlight division of the state highway department.

A person who beats his way into motion picture theatre violates he law on the subject of tresspass, ludge Harris Bell of the Austin Corporation Court held in assessing a fine of \$25 and costs against two vouths who had slipped into an Austin film show without buying tickets of admission. The court's bill against each of the lads was

The Attorney General is to write on opinion construing the new highway law requiring highway officers o be in uniform, wear badges and prohibited from making traps to atch motorists for speeding. The law requires County Commissioners to pay them \$150 per month salary, instead of fees based on apprehend ng motorists.

W. B. Shoe, head of the Workmen's Compensation Bureau of the State Fire Insurance Commission, has resigned, effective July 1, it is announced by J. J. Timmins, member of the commission. Shoe has been an insurance rate expert with the commission for two years, coming here rom Washington. His plans were not announced and his vacancy has not been filled.

Parents living near cities and towns may send their children to public schools in town without pay ing tuition, the Third Court of Civil appeals ruled in the case of E. R. Huck et al. vs. the Public Free Schools of Austin. The court reversed the Travis County Distric Court decision, which ruled that non residents could not send their children to public schools in Austin without payment of a tuition fee.

The permanent school fund at resent has \$713,000 of school disrict bonds uninvested, State Superntendent of Public Instruction S. M. Marrs announces. School districts have voted bonds with rate of inerest at 51/2 and 6 per cent and the bonds have brought premium on he market. It is probable that the State Board of Education will use to grant waivers and meet the ampetition in order to keep the school funds invested.

The Attorney general's department has approved an issue of \$75,000 city of Littlefield water works bonds bearing 6 per cent and maturing serially. The bonds have been registered in the comptroller's depart-

The State Contractors' Association will open an office in Austin on July 1, with L. W. Kemp in charge. To keep in touch with legislation and the State departments is the purpose of establishing as office at the State capital.



Texas News !!

An issue of \$37,500 City of Rockwall ewer bonds, bearing 51/2 per cent and naturing serially, has been proved by he attorney general's department.

The city commissioners of Texas City have passed an order calling for in election July 20 on a \$130,000 public streets improvement bond issue.

The Grape Creek common school disrict in Northeastern Tom Green Couny has voted to issue \$10,000 in bonds for erection of a new school building.

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe railroad has taken over control of the Julf and Northern Railroad of Texas by payment of \$100,000 for all of the capital stock.

Scattered infestation of leaf worm has appeared in the cotton fields in the southern half of Nueces County, eccording to George C. Palmer, county agricultural agent.

New key rates for fire insurance, has been granted by the state fire insurance commission as follows: Blooming Grove, 60 cents; Electra, 43 cents, and Giddings, 80 cents.

State aid is being sought to complete the road from Winnsboro through Franklin County to the Sulphur River Completion of this road will afford Winnsboro and Mount Vernon a fine outlet north and south.

The tomato crops in the Alto section this season ripened many days sooner than the 1924 crops. The first tomatoes in 1924 were shipped from Alto, June 9, and on that date this year the biggest portion of the crop had already been shipped

It cost an average of \$23.62 each to naintain the 12,669 wards of the state eleemosynary institutions in May, a tatement issued Saturday by the state poard of control said. The average cost for the nine months of the present fiscal year was \$23.30.

Three Panola County road districts have petitioned the commissioners court for road bond elections, looking to voting a total of \$79,000 for highway construction in the county. The districts petitioning for the bond elections are Midyett, Woods and Horton.

The appointment of E. E. Davis, prolessor of education in the Stephen F. Austin State Teachers College as dean of the North Texas Junior Agricultural College at Arlington to succeed M. L. Williams, has been announced by President W. B. Bizzell of A. and M.

Smith County claims the largest exclusive asparagus farm in Texas. Asparagus tips have been shipped from the county in car lots, and asparagus production is one of the county's sources of revenue from farming in addition to truck, fruit and general

The New Orleans, Texas and Mexico railroad has asked the interstate commerce commission permission to acquire control of six carriers in Texas by an outlay of \$4,700,000. The San Antonio, Uvalde and Gulf, the largest f the lines, is 318 miles long. The thers are the Sugar Land Railroad ompany, Asherton and Gulf. Rio rande City Company, Asphalt Belt and Lake Pipe Line Company.

A plea for the citizens of Texas to keep a safe and sane Fourth of July has been issued by J. J. Timmins, state fire marshal. He says that although ireworks are not used extensively in Texas in observance of the anniverary of the signing of the declaration f independence, that every effort hould be made to prevent accidents, ire and other tragedies usually acompanying display of fireworks.

Squirrels are the only fur bearing nimals that can be hunted in both ones in the state at this time. Red ox and gray squirrels may be killed n both zones in May, June and July, with a bag limit of 10 in a day. The season is open on squirrels at all times f the year in Edwards, DeWitt, Caldell, Guadalupe, San Saba, Mason, Gillespie, Llano, Kimball, Menard, Comal, McCulloch, Brown, Kerr, Burnet, Mills and Schleicher.

The growers in the San Benito Valy are taking time by the forelock and praying their groves liberally with cisons as protection against the avages of pests that are now to be ound in many of the best orchards of he county. Some of the most beautiful as well as most productive groves of the entire Valley are to be found the vicinity of San Benito, and it is with a desire to prevent them being injured that so much attention at this ime of the year is being given them.

The attorney general's department has approved an issue of \$75,000 City of Littlefield waterworks bonds, bearing 6 per cent and maturing serially.

The Texas railroad commission will oin the interstate commerce commission in hearing applications for permits to build three railroads in the Texas Panhandle, it was announced this week by C. V. Terrell, acting chairman. The Texas body has suggested the hearings be held at Plainview July 20, on aplication of the Ft. W. and D. S. P., Carey to Dimmitt, and from Silverton to Lubbock; the pecos and Santa Fe to build from Plainview to Dimmitt, and from Lidder to Silverton, The cases will be heard together.
