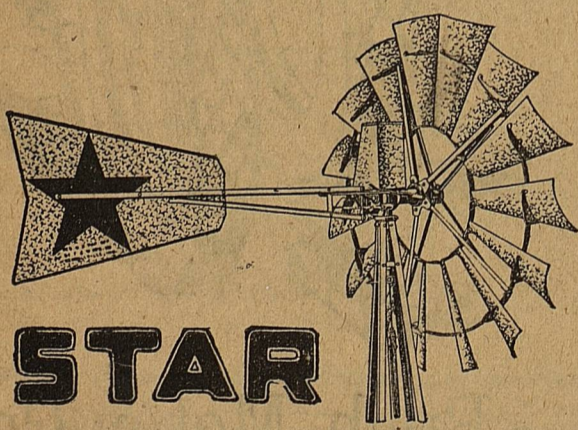

Surviving her are three sons, Tom Johnson of El Dorado, John Johnson of Cheapside, and Everett Johnson of Abilene, and four daughters, Mrs. Cora Putman of El Dorado, Mrs. Fanny Conner of Kingsbury, Mrs. Mona Young of Galveston and Mrs. Claude Lee of Cheapside. Her husband passed away 12 years ago.

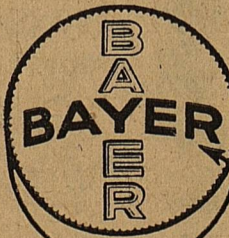

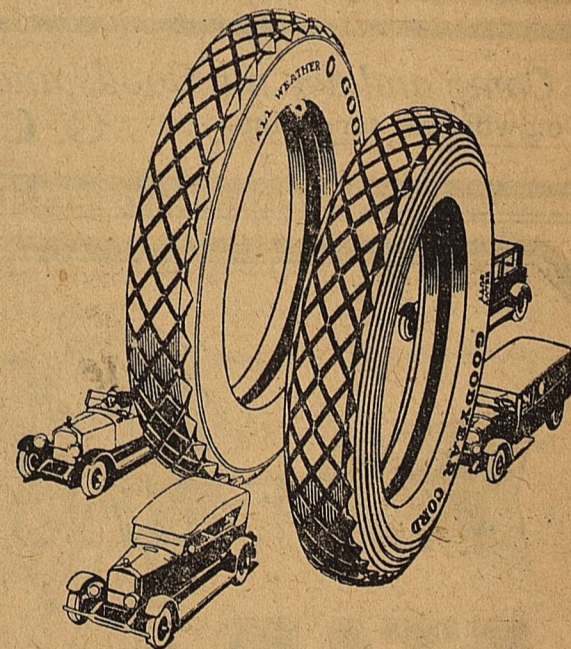

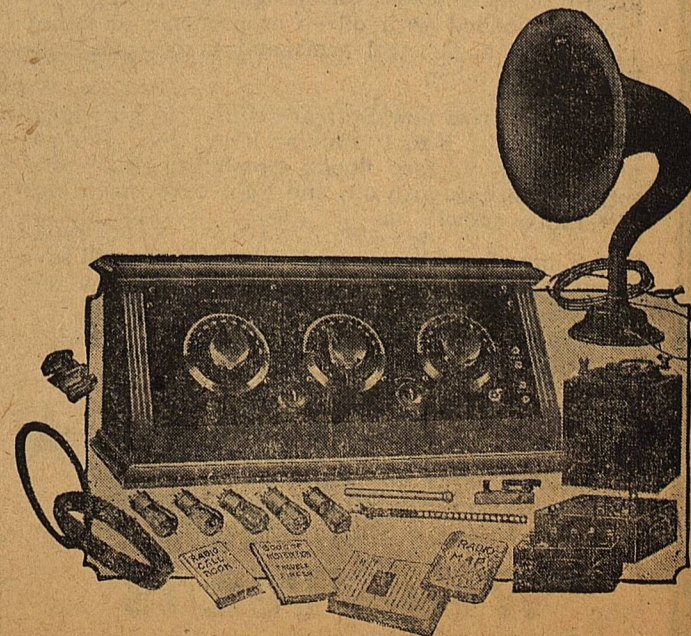
