MENARD GIRL AWARDED CARNIGIE MEDAL.

The winning of a bronze Carnegie medal and \$1,600 in cash as a reward for personal heroism is something that is accomplished by few. It is an honor that anyone should appreciate. Miss Imogene Lovelace, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. J. R. Lovelace, has won this distinction and has been awarded by the Carnegie Hero Commission the bronze medal and a sum not to exceed \$1,600 to be applied on her education for an act of personal service and heroism.

The saving of three lives is an act that merits more than passing notice. And this is what Miss Imogene did. While only nine years of age, she rescued three drowning children from the San Saba river June 21, 1923, as the following will explain.

In the instance herein mentioned, Mrs. C. M. Simmons must share this honor, for it was she who urged the parents to place the matter before the Carnegie Hero Commission. She did the correspondence, filled out the lengthy questionnaire and rendered such other courtesies as were necessary to bring about the investigation that proved the merits of the incident to the Commission.—Menard Messenger.

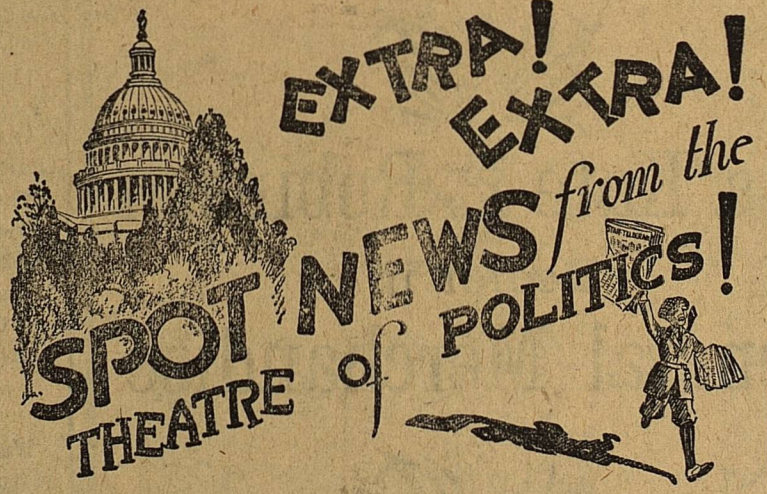

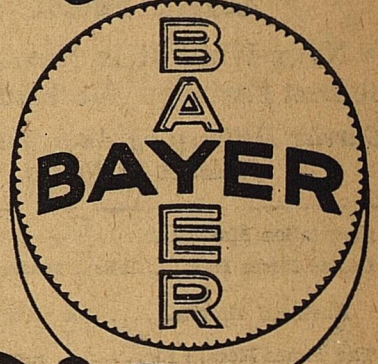
