The school in the town of Eldorado alone now has a total of 331 pupils enrolled with the prospects for the enrollment to reach well over 350 during the year. The other schools in the district now have an enrollment of 18 pupils, making the total enrollment of the district 349. Five years ago the enrollment of the district, exclusive of Mexicans, was only 299 and ten years ago the total enrollment was 223. Seventeen teachers are now employed in the Eldorado district as compared with 13 in 1923 and 7 in 1918. These are figures taken from the superintendents annual report for those years.



#### CANNING POULTRY CULLS

"The pantry shelf is a good place to put the loafer hen culled out of the poultry flock this fall provided she is well encased in tin," so home demonstration authorities of Texas A. & M. College Extension Service declare. Years ago it was nearly out of the question for the housewife to can meat but since the invention of the steam pressure canner all has changed. The barn yard skeik and the boarder hen are now turned to profit by this means on thousand of Tex-

In canning chickens care must be taken that the meat is not over-cooked and that as little iquid as possible is used in order that the delicate poultry fiavor may be retained. Older birds hay be boned by splitting the mesh down the back and removmg it from the skeleton with a
