Transfusions Can Save Life The body of an aver-
age -sized man contains age sized man contains
about 13 pints of blood. The about 13 pints of blood. The
sudden loss of less than half sudden loss of less than half
that amount threatens his that
life.

Blood transfusions can
help save it-with the aid of a blood bank.
The Texas Medical As. sociation says serious blood
loss during injury, child. loss during injury, child.
birth, an operation, or a
disease that disease that causes hemor-
raging can lead to shock raging can lead to shock
and, left untreated, even and, left untreated, even
death. The person in shock may receive a whole blood
transfusion or certain blood components.
For operations, a trans-
fusion may precede the profusion may precede the pro-
cedure and help the patient cedure and help the patient
build tolerance toward it. Or a transfusion may take place
during the operation to offset lost blood.
For an operatic For an operation that may
require a transfusion, the require a transfusion, the
doctor orders procedures to match blood from the blood bank with that of the patient. Human blood
comes in four types: $A, B$, comes in four types: $\mathrm{A}, \mathrm{B}$,
AB , and O . The most com. mon are $O$ and $A$. Blood the
patient receives must be compatible with his own. The donor's and patient's
blood also are tested for blood also are tested for
sensitivity to other factors, sensitivity to other factors,
which occur particularly in which occur particularly in
people who have received people who have received
previous transfusions or have been pregnant. Recent developments in
blood banking have blood banking have made it
possible to separate blood possible to separate blood
into many of its compo. into many of its compo-
nents: white blood cells for
fighting infection fighting infection, red blood cells for delivering oxygen, and platelets for helping
stop bleeding, along with numerous components of
the liquid (plasma) part of the liquid (plasma) part of
the blood. Each component can save lives under the
right circumstances right circumstances.

researchers now have successfuly changed type B red
blood cells into type O cells blood cells into type O cells
by using an enzyme f om by using an enzyme from
green coffee beans. The green coffee beans. The
enzyme-alpha galactosidose $\cdots$ removes a sugar
molecule from the surface of molecule from the surface of
the type $B$ cells, turning them into type O cells. The find a similar method for changing type $A$ blood into
