CHICKENS AND EGGS SOLD MAKE FAMILY COMFORTABLE

Comfort and financial security were attained last year by a Colorado woman through her poultry keeping, although the main crop was almost a failure.

A report received by the United States Department of Agriculture states that after culling her flock and selling the culled for \$100, this woman bought lumber to enlarge the poultry house so as to have more space for the pullets retained.
