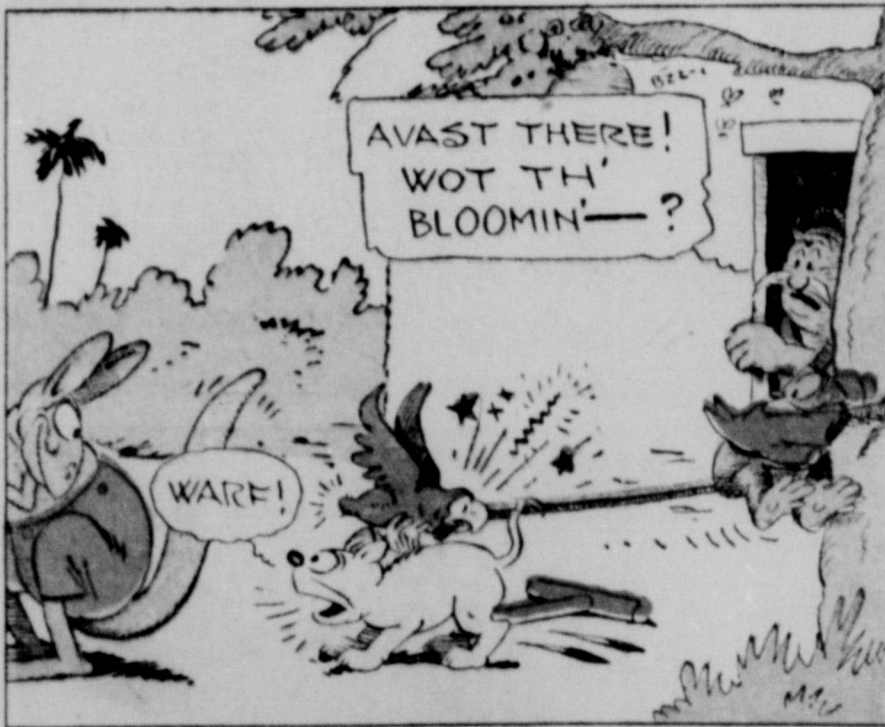
CAP'N KIDD
