State Capital News

Highlight of the Holiday Season at your State Capitol always is the annual Christmas party held in the House of Representatives.

This year's festive celebration was a children's Life Corps gift from Mexico City and the climax of the revelry always is the group singing of Christmas songs around a giant Christmas tree erected in the rotunda. This year's tree is 32-feet tall, decorated with brilliant lights. It is so huge and heavy that a crew of workers had to hoist it into place by guide ropes secured to the floor balcony. Watching the tree get everyone in the spirit.

After the giant tree went up, Preston Smith and the First Lighted the Mansion tree--a 10-foot lace cedar. It was lit by a retired Central Texas couple, Mr. and Mrs. George Dow Sr. of Gay Hill near Austin.

Thousands of Texans make the pilgrimage to the state capitol to admire the beauty of the capitol building and the magnificent views of the surrounding hills and the Governor's residence.

TAX CUT!-----
As state taxes go up, the unemployment insurance tax paid by Texas employers goes down again in 1970--for the third straight year--according to the Texas Employment Commission.

Employers will be able to deduct 1.2 per cent from the experience rate effective January 1, reports W. S. Well Jr., employer representative on the commission.

Under the law, when the unemployment compensation fund, which is \$300 million, as of October 1, the rate must be reduced. This October it totaled \$355 million.

The payroll tax paid by the employer will be about \$23 million less. Not all employers benefit. About 65 per cent of the firms will pay a smaller rate. More than 90 per cent of the covered employers now pay the minimum 0.1 per cent.

WATER QUALITY PLANS TOLD
Twenty-three northeast Texas cities and corporations have told the Texas Water Quality Board their plans for improving water quality.

City managers were invited to report on what they are doing to improve water quality. Also conducted hearing on proposals to require self-reporting from firms and cities that discharge waste materials.

DRIVING URGED-----
Governor Smith has appealed to Texas drivers to use "utmost caution" during coming holiday season.

Department of Public Safety reported traffic crashes in state during the Christmas-New Year season may claim as many as 87 lives.

The governor and the DPS want to prevent the court from declaring a state of emergency on January 5.

Jack Roberts Federal District Court in Austin. Members of the Richard Chase Defense Committee filed the suit on behalf of Private Chase, who is now being held in the Fort Hood Stockade. The 26-year old soldier is charged with disobeying a direct order and refusing to take part in riot-control training at the Central Texas Army base.

PUBLIC SCHOOL EDUCATION-----
A group of private citizens is distributing an eight-page booklet summarizing the results of the controversial report of the Governor's Committee on Public School Education (COPESE).

Booklet includes a rundown of the accomplishments to date and those that became law even in a modified sense. It also advocates action on the "additional improvements proposed by COPESE which are still needed to give Texas a first-class public school system".

Included in that section are the proposals for tax equalization and consolidation of smaller schools that raised so much furor during the legislative session.

CARGO PERMIT ASKED-----
Texas Aeronautics Commission held hearing on application of Lubbock-Amarillo Armored Service Inc. for permit to transport cargo by air.

SHORT SHORTS-----
State Rep. Bob Armstrong of Austin has announced that he will run for Land Commissioner against the incumbent Jerry Sadler, who plans to seek reelection.

Harris, Dallas and Lee Counties have been placed under federal quarantine for hog cholera as a result of an outbreak of the swine disease.

Texas Supreme Court has licensed 251 new attorneys.

City Sales Tax Approved By Light Turnout 4 to 1

About a third of the eligible voters turned out Saturday to give a 4 to 1 approval of a 1 per cent city sales tax in an election called by the City Council.

A total of 120 voted for the tax, while 31 registered disapproval. About 500 persons were eligible.

The tax is expected to yield an estimated \$10,000 to \$15,000 annually to the city. It will become effective April 1, 1970.

City officials expect the tax to supplement revenue lost from municipal gas wells, and funds will be used for city improvements, a council spokesman said.
