The answer is NO. The Texas Constitution says: "The Legislature may pass Laws prescribing the qualifications of practitioners of Medicine in the State, and to punish persons for Mal-pructice, but NO PREFERENCE SHALL EVER BE GIVEN BY LAW TO ANY SCHOOL OF MEDI. CINE."
