THE VOTERS of the state of Texas, at least a majority of those who went to the polls in the election November
8 , prefer to continue payment of a poll tax as a requirement of voting-so that poll tax must be paid again if
you desire to take part in the elections next year. In the election, the proposed constitutional amendment
pertaining to the abolition of the poll tax also called for a registration system, with the registration system allowing a registration fee. State legislators, in anticipation
of the amendment passing, drew up and approved a regof the amendment passing, drew up and approved a reg-
tstration law, setting the fee at 50 cents. Present poil
tax is $\$ 1.75$, and some towns and cities have an additional tax is $\$ 1$
city tax. Perhaps many voters felt that they might as well pay Furthermore, the amendment did not limit the registration

the amendment were amended later, it would have been possible for the legislature to write and pass a law re-
quiring a registration fee of $\$ 5$, $\$ 10$, or $\$ 100$, or just any figure they might decide upon.
Whatever the reason migit have been, the voters did

result, payment of the poll tax will again be a requirement for voting.
It should be explained that payment of your real estate,

poll tax was included as a compulsory matter. But that isn't the case now. You can pay your poli without paying
the rest of your taxes, or you can pay your other taxes without paying your poll tax.

a general rule, will be held. There will likely be a number of candidates, both county and state candidates. You will want to vote for or against these candidates. And
