This Cycle Is All Motor



Powered by a 32-horsepower engine, this motorcycle, driven by Freddie Luther, and designed by A. Thullier, has been undergoing tests on Murco Dry Lake, Calif., preparatory to an assault on speed records over the salt flats near Salt Lake City.
