









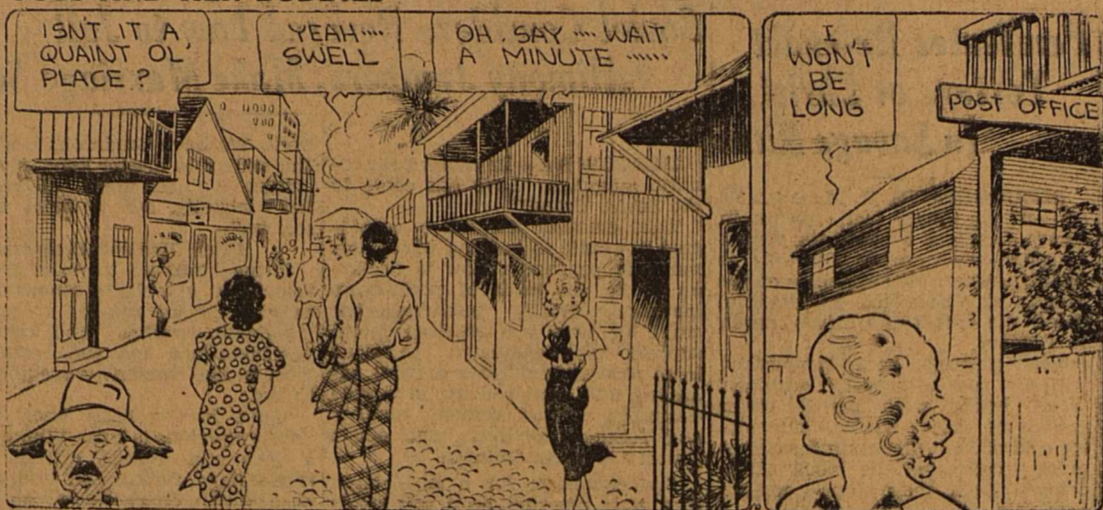
Chimes Not for Jazz.

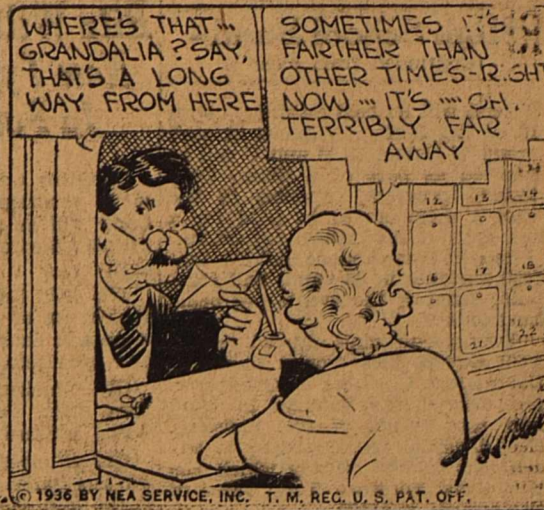
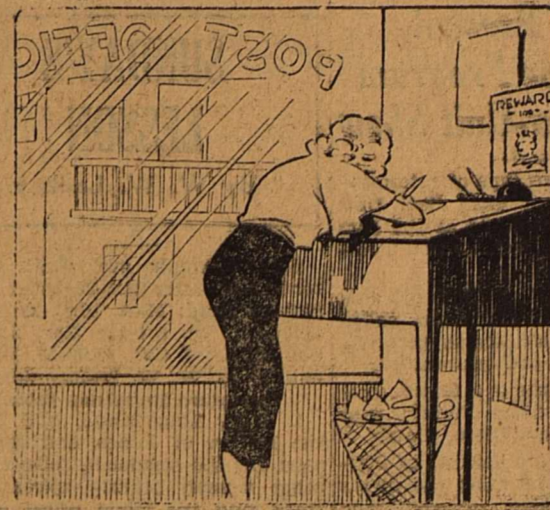
Heirloom Stolen in Scotland.
