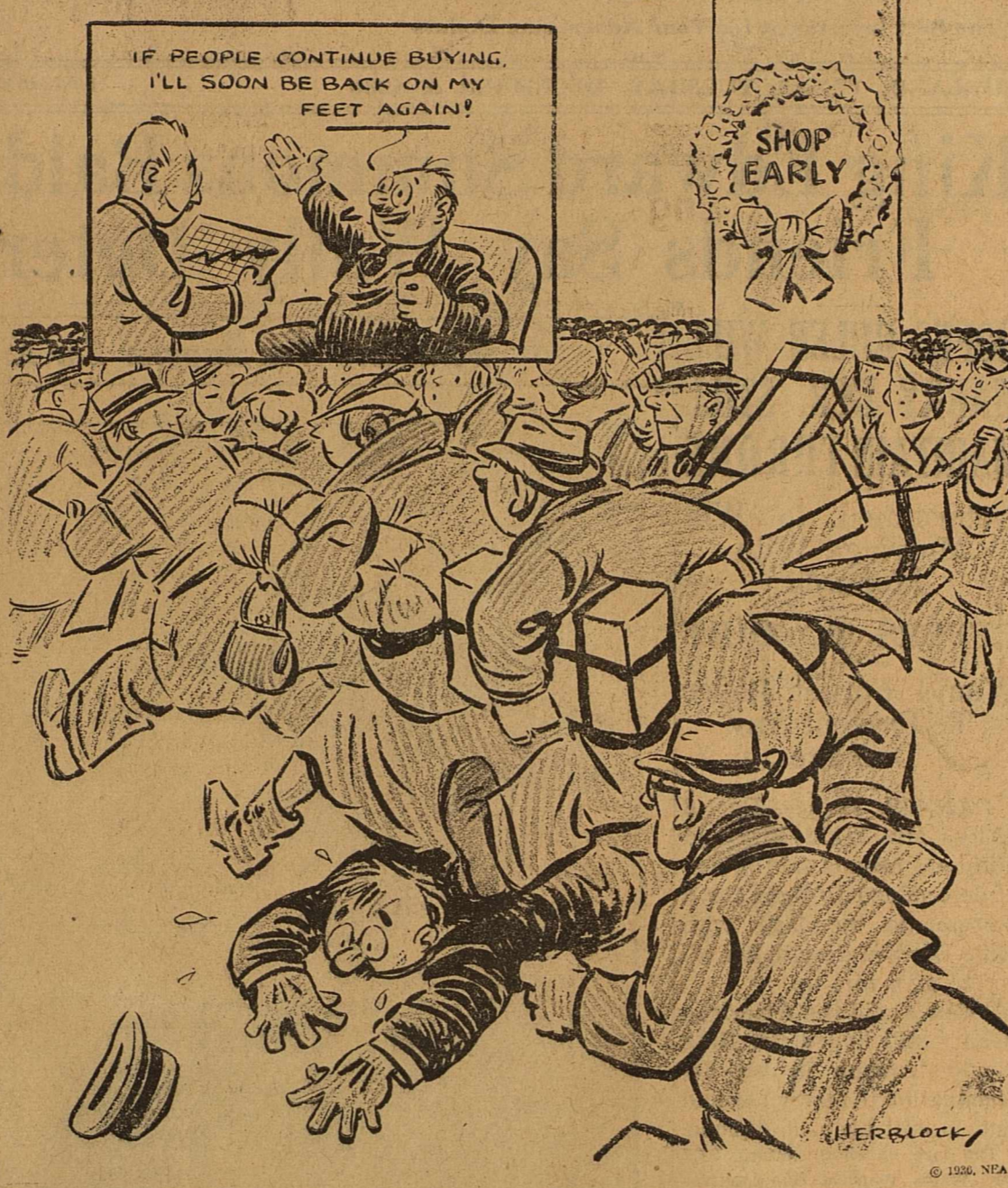

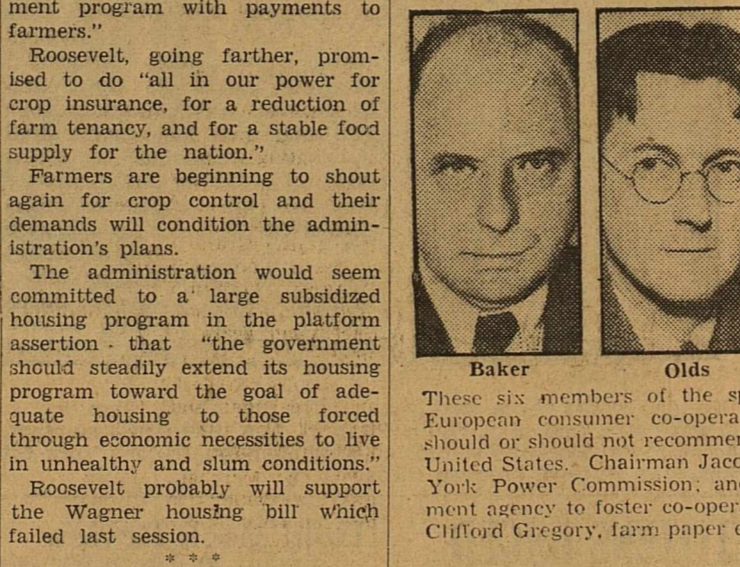


BEHIND THE SCENES IN WASHINGTON

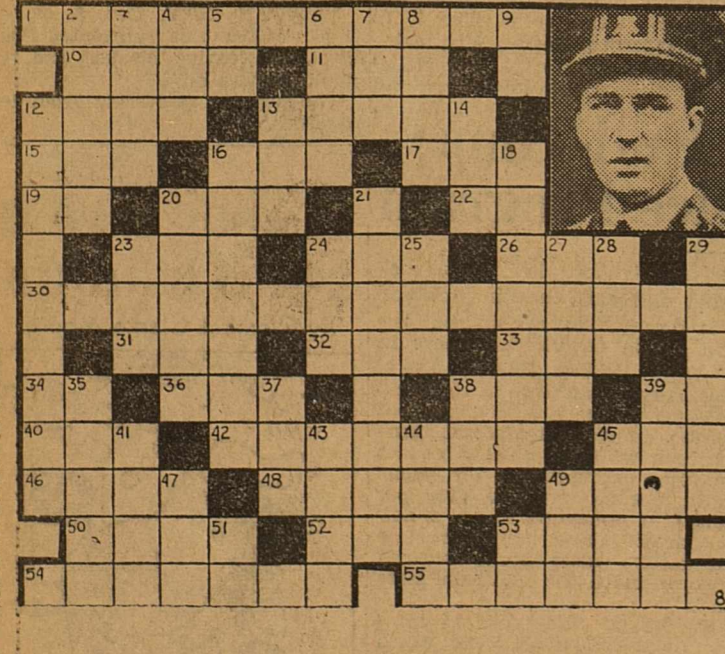

Christmas shopping is not the only kind you had better do early to avoid the rush.

Tickets for the Midland Bulldog-Littlefield Wildcats football game here Friday afternoon went on sale this morning and they are being sold like firecrackers on July 4.

There have been some complaints at the price of the tickets being doubled for this game, but school officials have a ready answer to all protests. Littlefield charged \$1 each for their bi-district game with Snyder last Friday and would have charged the same for the Midland game had it been played on their field. Furthermore, such a heavy guarantee was demanded of Mid-

land for the game that the school would undoubtedly have come out in the hole charging the usual price.

What's more, many local football enthusiasts have paid three times as much to see college and university games this year that were not as good as the game here Friday will be.

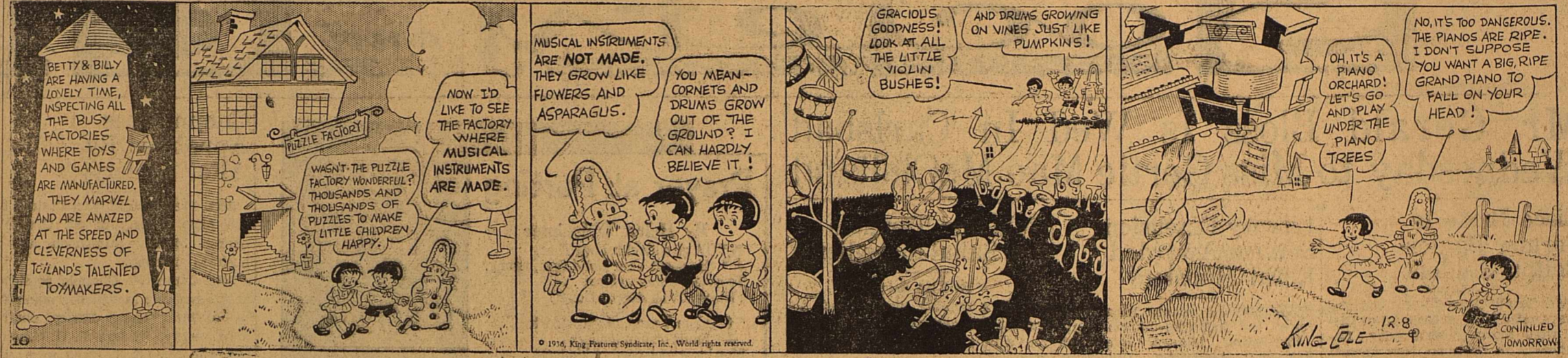
Having seen Littlefield play, this department is not just making artificial interest for the game when it says that they have a tough club.

For the second time this season Midland will be meeting a club that will outweigh them. And no better proof can be given than this in regards to their passing attack: Littlefield completed 15 out of 20 passes against Snyder—and a drizzling rain was falling all during the contest. Furthermore, it was as cold as Santa Claus' home town.

When Littlefield failed to gain against Snyder in the first period the other day they finally sent in a "substitute" end—one Tom Morgan. And he made no more difference to the club than did Sam Baugh to the TCU team. The small person that was braving the elements started a concerted yell as Morgan went in for the Wildcat quarterback to pass to him. (It might be well to mention here that Morgan is a little runt about 6 feet 4 inches tall). The quarterback responded—and how! The first play was a 20-yard pass to Morgan that put the ball on the Snyder 22. The next was another pass to the same person that put the ball on the Snyder 2. From that point one of the backs managed to break through the line.

The Wildcats waited at least three minutes before they scored again. And no need to say who made the score. Morgan just stood in the end zone, nochantly leaped high in the air and took a 15-yard pass as three Snyder boys tried desperately to touch the ball.

Snyder finally managed to score and then Littlefield turned on more steam. Just to prove that Morgan was not the only man that could

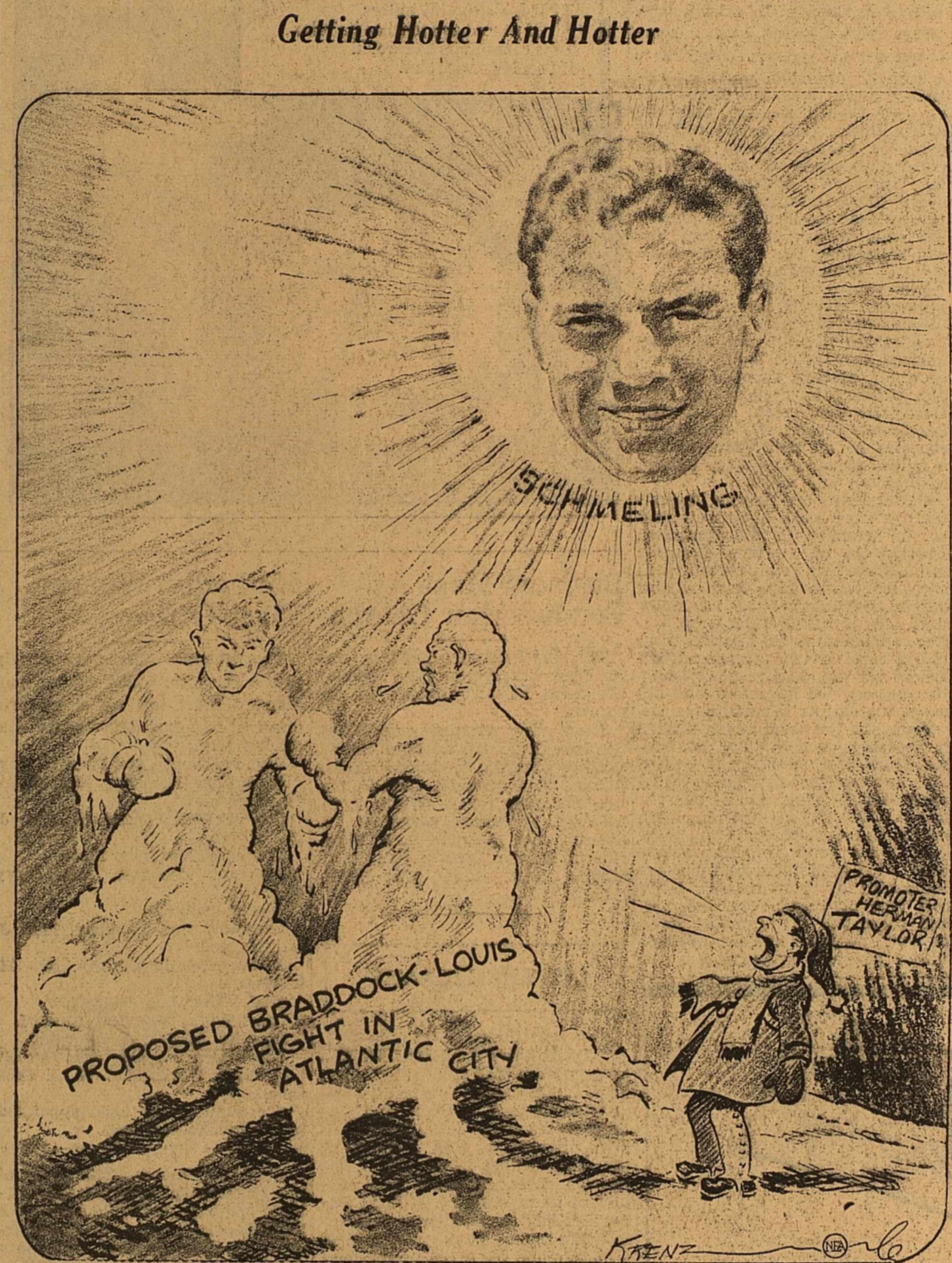

Unless memory fails he got a hand on only one punt and returned that one for about 30 yards before being pushed out of bounds.

The Littlefield guards are small but the club really has the weight and size over the rest of the line. At that, the guards are probably larger than any Midland has.

4 RR COMMISSION EMPLOYEES OUSTED

ire of Lon A. Smith is Aroused By Action Of Leaders

AUSTIN, Dec. 8 (P.)—Dismissal of four railroad commission employees assertedly without his knowledge aroused the ire Monday of Commissioner Lon A. Smith, who declared the procedure "extremely unusual."

Smith said he learned of the removal of oil supervisors Homer Pierson at Dallas and Omar Burkett at Eastland and motor division employees Cam Murray of Abilene and John Donaldson of Waco, effective Dec. 15, only when he saw the letter of dismissal.

Declaring the commission usually holds conferences on changing staff members and that he believed he was in Austin at the time the action was taken, Smith said:

"The procedure was extremely unusual. I don't care to add anything to that today but I may have a statement tomorrow." Asked if there were others who might be dismissed in the near future, Smith replied: "Not that I know of. That's four too many."

Commissioner C. V. Terrell, next chairman under the rotation plan, declined to comment and Chairman Ernest O. Thompson was not in the city.

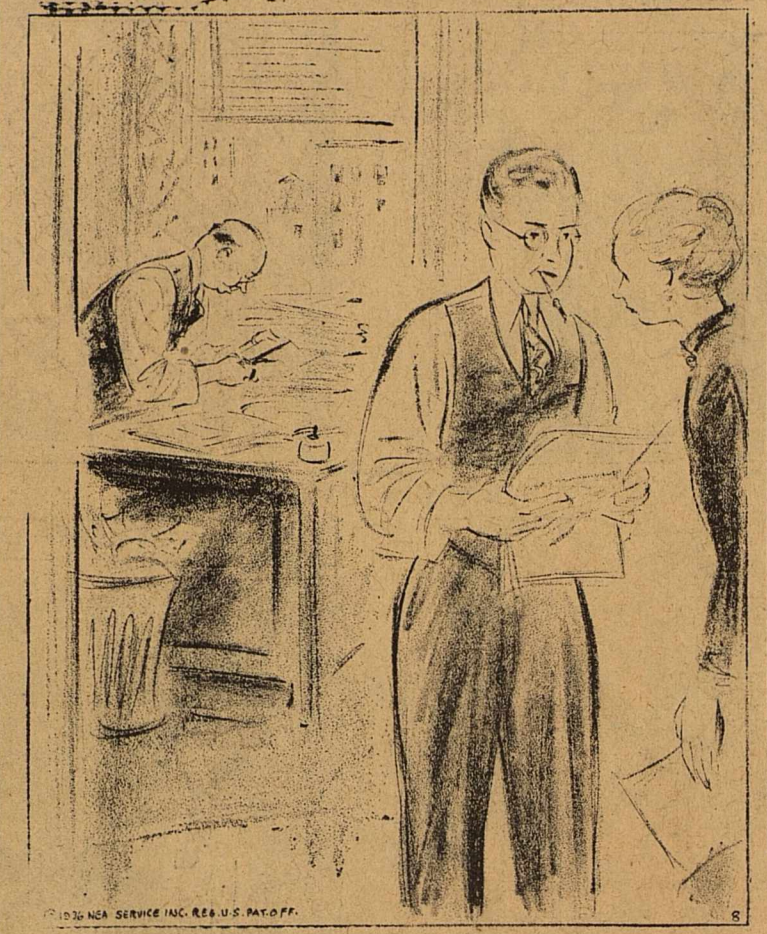

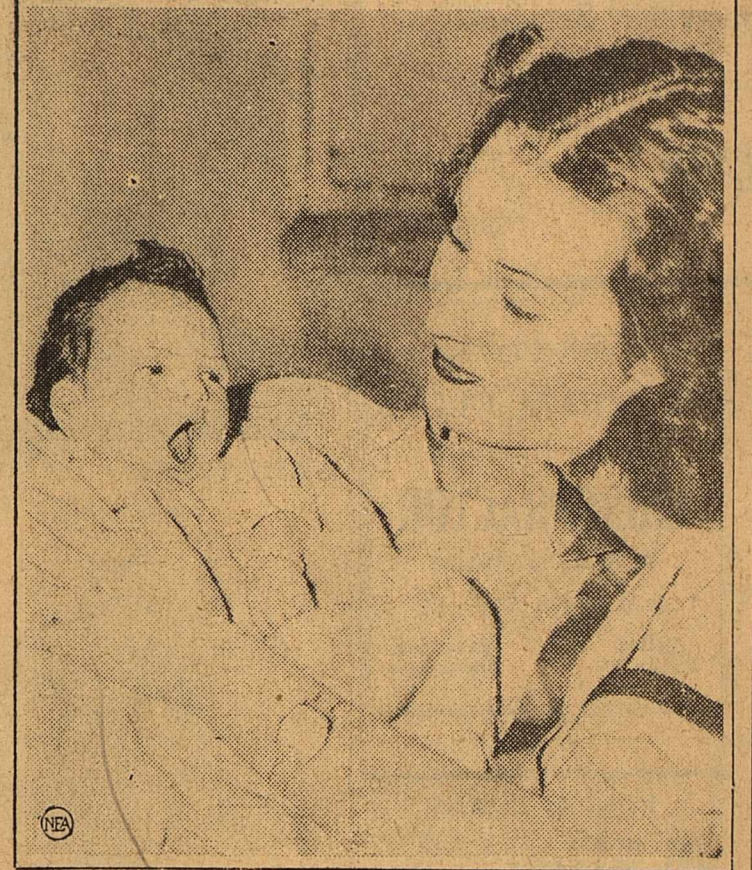
