Judge Hill Gets Reports From CMT Camps Over State

While the county chairman of Midland county is working at the problem of getting more and more boys to join the CMTC recruits from here, reports come in from other camps over the country, showing human interest associated with life in the CMTC and of various provisions being made for the work and play and instruction of recruits.

The latest report to come to Judge Hill, Midland county chairman, follows:

The vanguard of young Texans enrolled in the Citizens Military Training Camp at Fort Sam Houston, Texas, June 14th to July 13th, using almost every mode of transportation from "collegiate Fords" to special trains, began reporting early Wednesday to CMTC headquarters. With additional students arriving hourly, assurance is given of full attendance at the ninth CMT Camp. All preparations to examine, clothe and mess the twelve hundred or more who have requested training this year have been completed. The problem of giving each student a thorough physical examination, uniforming and assigning him to an organization will require all of Friday, the opening day.

At an early morning assembly Saturday, all students will be instructed in hygiene and camp sanitation. They will also hear an address on "Citizenship" given by Chaplain H. A. Hoagney, 23rd Infantry. Later in the morning General S. D. Rookerbach, Camp Commander, will administer to the assembled student body, the C. M. T. C. oath. Reimbursement for travel expenses will be made to the students on Saturday afternoon. Protestant and Catholic services will be held Sunday morning at 8:00 o'clock. Students desiring to attend services in San Antonio will be permitted to do so.

The Regimental Staff, Companies B, C, G, H, I, L, and Headquarters Co. of the 9th Infantry, supplemented by Battery A, 12th Field Artillery and the Second Signal Company, will constitute the parent organizations for training, administration and supply of the Camp.
