## VARSITY LAND IN ECTOR, ANDREWS SELLS MARCH 29

The University of Texas leasing board will sell to the highest bidder on March 29 oil and gas leases on university lands in Ector and Andrews counties, Miss Gussie Cottingham, secretary, announced.

A minimum annual rental of \$1 per acre and a royalty of not less than one-sixth of the gross production of oil and a royalty of not less than one-eighth of the dry gas, casinghead gas and residue gas has been fixed for the Ector county lands, and a minimum annual rental of not less than \$1 and a royalty of not less than one-eighth of the gross production of oil and gas was fixed for the Andrews county tracts.

Ector county tracts offered: South one-half of the northwest quarter of section 2, and south one-half of the north one-half of section 3, both in block 35.


All of the Andrews county land is in block 13, as follows: Northeast quarter, northwest quarter, southeast quarter and southwest quarter of section 6, northwest quarter and south half of section 5, and north half and south half of section 4.



As he was seeking a landing spot about two miles west of the airport, a wheel was knocked from the landing gear and it was then necessary to land on only one wheel.

## MAN WHO LANDED HERE WHILE ENROUTE TO FATHER'S AID GOES INTO MEXICO

Gordon Bristow, son of J. W. Bristow, oi operator and mining man held by Mexican bandits in the wild mountain regions back of Mazatlan, departed by train for Mazatlan Friday night at 6:30 o'clock. He planned to enter Mexico through Nogales, Sonora.

Expressing his conviction that American consular officials were better qualified to effect a rescue than any other agencies on the west coast of Mexico, young Bristow said before leaving that he had placed his rescue program entirely under their direction.

American Consul William P. Blocker at Juarez had received no communications Friday from Vice-Consul Eaton, assigned from the Mazatlan consulate to investigate the kidnaping and holding of J. W. Bristow for ransom.

It was believed that contact with the emissaries of the bandit gang had not been made by Mexican officials. The ransom sum remained undetermined, being variously announced at 30,000 or 10,000 and 3,000 pesos.

Acting on the advice of Consul Blocker, Gordon Bristow was to proceed to Mazatlan and leave the details of his father's release in the hands of Vice-Consul Eaton.

"Obie" Bristow is well known among the Midland people who are from Oklahoma. Bristow was a member of the varsity football team in the University of Oklahoma at Norman, in the years of 1924 and 1925, when his work on the team brought him to the attention of the entire student body.

"Obie" was exceedingly popular in

ties. Bristow was a member of the Kappa Sigma social fraternity at the University of Oklahoma. He came to West Texas with his father about two years ago and with his rare adjustability has become a thorough West Texan.

He landed Wednesday in Midland while en route to El Paso, where he hoped to obtain the release of his father. He will fly back through Midland, he said while here.
