Choice Cooks' Corner Peach Shortcake Two cups pastry flour, 1 table-spoon baking powder, 1 table-spoon salt, 11-2 table-spoons fat, 1-3 cup evaporated milk, 1-3 cup water, 6 ripe juicy peaches, 2-3 cups sugar. Sift flour, then measure. Resift twice with baking powder, salt and 11-2 table-spoons sugar.

Berry Topping One-half cup evaporated milk 11-2 table-spoon lemon juice, few grains salt, 1-2 cup berry pulp, sugar to taste. Scald milk in double boiler. Chill thoroughly and beat until stiff.
