

Conference of Doctors Opens

FT. WORTH—Facing a tendency toward collectivism or socialism in the field of medicine, Dr. John H. Foster of Houston, president of the Texas Medical Association, declared here yesterday on the eve of the sixty-seventh annual convention that he sees no cause for radical changes in the present individualism as applied to the practice of medicine.

The vanguard of 1,500 delegates began arriving yesterday for the preliminary conferences today before the general meeting is called to order at 10 a. m. tomorrow at the Texas hotel. Most of the physicians will arrive today.

Socialism in medicine, or medical economics as Dr. Foster prefers to call the subject, will get its introduction before the house of delegates, the governing body of the association, which met at the Blackstone hotel today. Dr. Foster was preparing yesterday to handle a mass of business, including committee reports which will be given to reference committees for consideration.

Dr. Foster terms the report of the council on medical economics as the most important subject to be considered by the house of delegates.

No definite action is expected before Wednesday or Thursday. After today's session the delegates probably will adjourn until Wednesday night. Other highlights on today's preliminary program include conferences by societies and organizations, members of which are associated with the medical association. Two hundred city and county health officers are expected for the opening of a conference headed by Dr. John W. Brown, state health officer today at the Texas hotel. State, city and county health problems will be taken up by speakers.

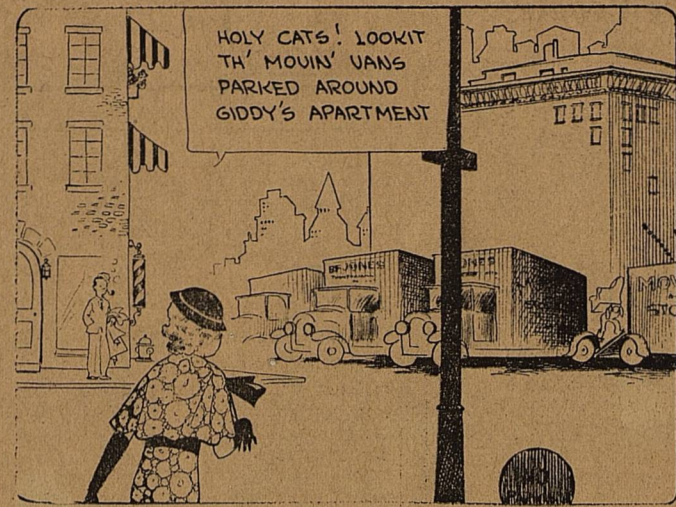
Cheese Led 1932 "Dairy Parade"

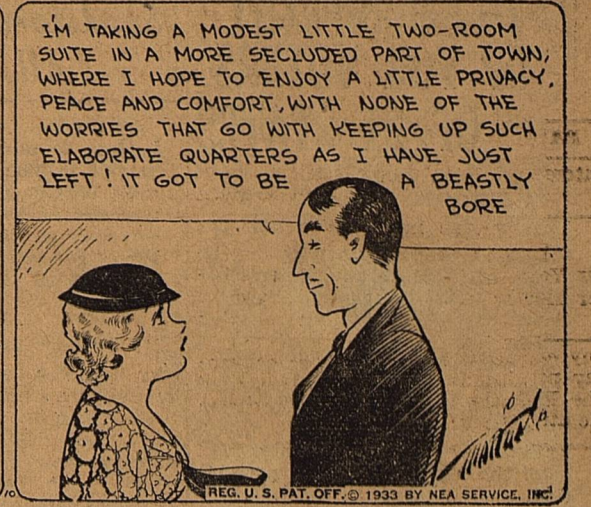
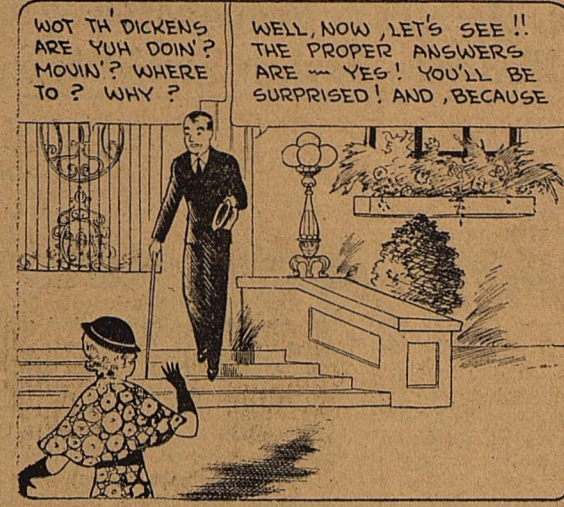
Close behind came ice milk and evaporated milk. These three dairy products were the only ones in the dairy family showing production increase in 1932.

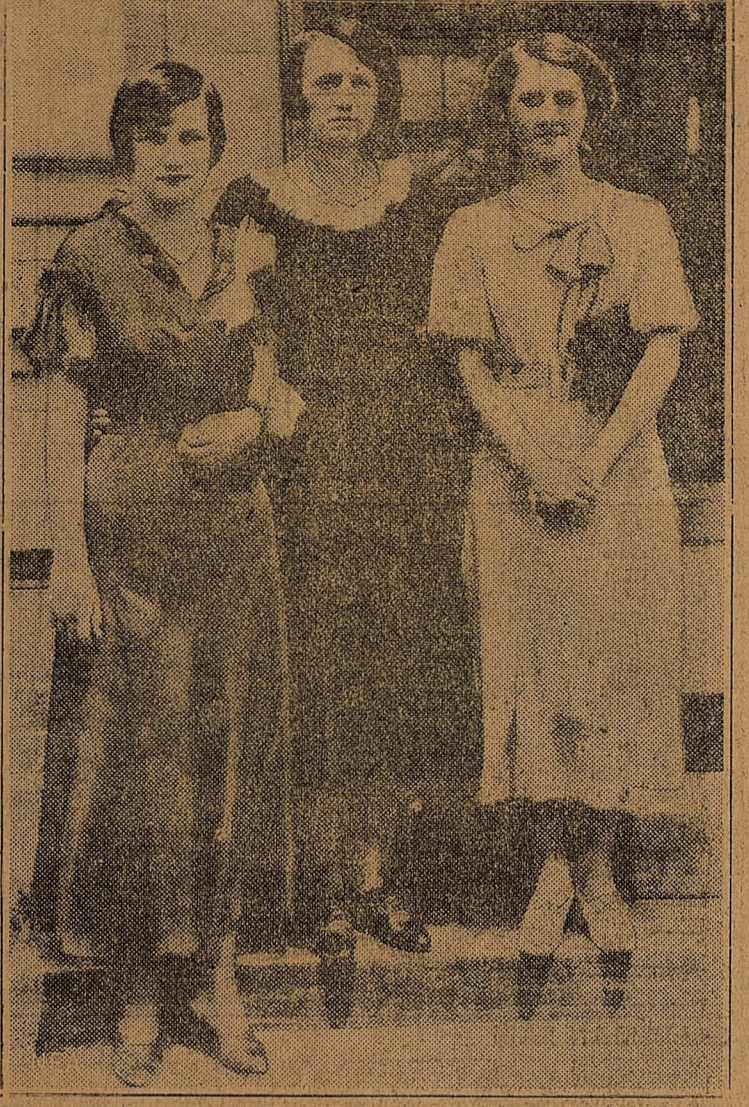
