sanded, "tacked" (cleaned of saw. dust with a special rag), sealed, re-sanded and re-tacked. Then two background coats of paint are
applied, with sanding and tacking in between. A krylon mat (varnish) goes on next and then finally the
pattern is transposed from it pattern is transposed from it
tracing paper to the surface with Thy The detailed painting then The detailed painting then be-
gins, which can often take weeks to gins, which can often take weeks to
complete. Following this, the tole painter must erase any markings,
tack, krylon coat, use a "mud and tack, krylon coat, use a "mud an
linseed oil" technique for antio uing and then krylon varnish again often several times. By the time all
