ond hours，a systemic reaction may occur，character ized by restlessness，fever，chills，nausea，
weakness and joint pain．The bite also produces a smail blister surrounded by a large congested and smail bilister surrounded by a a arge congested and
swollen area．The venom usually kills the affected tissue，which gradually sloughs away and
exposes undertying tissues．The edges around exposes undertlying tissues．The edges around
the wound thicken，while the exposed center fills
with dense scar tissue．Healing may take six to with dense scar tissue．Healing may take six to
eight weeks，leaving scars of various sizes． spider＇s eyes and back markings．It has thre pairr of eyes arranged in a semi－circle on the
