## Built During 1906.

Special to the Globe-Democtat.
Atistin, Tex., December 25 .-R A. Thompson, engitheet of the state tailtoad comimiosion, has compled a complete statement of the Hew miles of railtoad constrticted in Texas during the year 1906 . The number of miles of hiew toad for that period is shown to be 648. It is believed that Fexas has led all other states this year in tailroad constritetion. In addition to this completed mileage, there are 1427 miles of adilitional road surveyed or under contract for construction, and much of it will be completed dur. ing the coming year.

The new mileage constructed during the present year is as forlows: Abmene and Nothern, ffom Abilene to Stamford, 40 miles. Beaunimit. Sour Lake and Western from Sour Lake to the Trinity river, 25 miles. Beaumiont and Greas Northerst, from Trimity river to Arlalaska, 15.7 miles. Galvestorn. Harrisburg and San Antomio, from Cuero to Stockdale, 47 minles. Fiots:
 Belt and Teriminal, itip city of Hiouston, 8 miles. Kanisas City. Mexico and Ortient, Sagertof to Kriox City, 2 r .9 miles, Planview and Northers Pexas, from Canyon to Planview, 57 miles. St Eotris Browisuill and Mexied, frotil Algoa to Brazoria, 26.6 tifiles. Texas Central, from Stamford to Dowell, 45 wilies. Prinity and Brazos Valley, from Mexia to Houston, and froth Teague rintth, 208 iniles. Wiehiti Valley, from seymore to Stamford, 60 ittiles.
