

An ordinance entitled an ordinance prohibiting chickens and other fowls from running at large within the corporate limits of the City of Matador prescribing a penalty for the violation thereof and declaring an emergency. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MATA-

That hereafter it shall be unlawful for the owner or custodians of any chicken or chickens of other fowls of any description to permit or allow them to run at large within the corporate ilmits of the city of Matador.

Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance hall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction in any court of competent jurisdiction shail be fined in any sum not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$100,00 and each day that such fowls as are numerated above




