| Planning for implementing the provisions of the new Speedy Trial Act in Texas has started in the sath District Court covering Hansford, Ochiltree and Hutchinson Counties but District Judge Richard Countiss of Spearman admits that several financial and problems at this time. The process is then repeated. <br> The judge also schedules several non-jury days in each county each month and during these times the grand juries are called and other court matters are handled. <br> Under the new law, every felony is to be tried within 120 days from time of arrest and the judge pointed out that this will result in some changes. <br> He said that one of them will be that the grand jury in each county will be called in at least once each month and criminal | Two changes in financing may be necessary to comply with provisions of the new law.
