| Everyone, regardless of age or place of birth, must now submit evidence of age, identi- ty, and U. S. citizenship or lawful admission status when applying for a social security number, Howard Weatherly Pampa, said today. <br> These procedures are intended to help protect the applicant's social security record assure that is complete and accurate, and to prevent anyone else from misusing or abusing the person's social security number, Weatherly said. <br> In addition, a person 18 or over who is applying for a number for the first time, must apply in person. <br> The best evidence of a person's age and U. S. citizenship is a birth certificate he stated. This should be submitted if possible. But, if it is not available, other documentary evidence can be used. <br> Evidence of identity should include documentation which shows the person's picture, signature, date of birth or age, or other identifying information. <br> Applicants not born in the U . S. should submit evidence of their U. S. citizenship or their immigration documents showing they are lawfully admitted to the U. S. <br> All documents submitted as evidence are subject to verification with the agency which issued them. <br> A person should allow plenty of time to get the number. It takes 5 to 6 weeks to issue the after all required evidence has been submitted. <br> A free ileaflet, "Applying for a social security number," can be obtained at the Pampa social security office. It tells what kinds of evidence can be used. The office is located at 1541 North Hobart Street and phone number is 669-3381. |
