MYSTERY HOME IS THE HOME PLACE OF MR. AND MRS. ROBERT OWNBY NEAR MORSE-PRINGLE

The Mystery home featured to day is the home of Mr. and Mrs. Robert Ownby, very prominent young ranchers of the Pringle Area.

In our issue of April 25th we had a Mystery Farm write-up of the Morse Ownby, but featured the family of Mr. and Mrs. F. A. Fatheree, who live at the former Robert Ownby home.

The present Mystery home is the old original Jim Ownby homestead and is truly a land-mark in this area of the Panhandle. It is a well improved two story home with 5 rooms down stairs and 3 rooms up stairs. The Mystery farm is one of the best improved Ranch homes in the Panhandle, and for many years the load facilities of the ranch was used by all cattle men up and down the creek.

The home place is just one section, but Mr. and Mrs. Ownbey own 1100 acres of grass land 2 miles East of the home section, and this of course comes under the operation of their cattle and other activities for their home place. The Ownby's own and supervise operation of some 3 sections of farm land near Morse and their total operations include more than seven sections of land in Hansford-Hutchinson counties.

Both these young folk are very talented and outstanding. Mrs. Ownby is a very talented writer and a member of the Texas Pen Women's organization. She has found time to supervise her family of 3 children who attend school at the Pringle school in Hutchinson county.

We regret that we do not have more detailed information about this young couple, but we made one trip to their home and they were not at home, and we left a note for Mrs. Ownby to mail us the information, and perhaps she failed to get the note.

This mystery farm was printed first in our issue of July 25th. It was correctly identified by little W. C. Womble, son of Mr. and Mrs. Boy Womble. Dick Allison phoned in the identification from his home in Kansas, but he was wrong.

The Mystery home printed August 1st is that of Mr. and Mrs. Billy Jarvis, and we have already had 11 people correctly identify this home. The write-up on the home will appear in our next weeks issue the Reporter printed for August 15th.

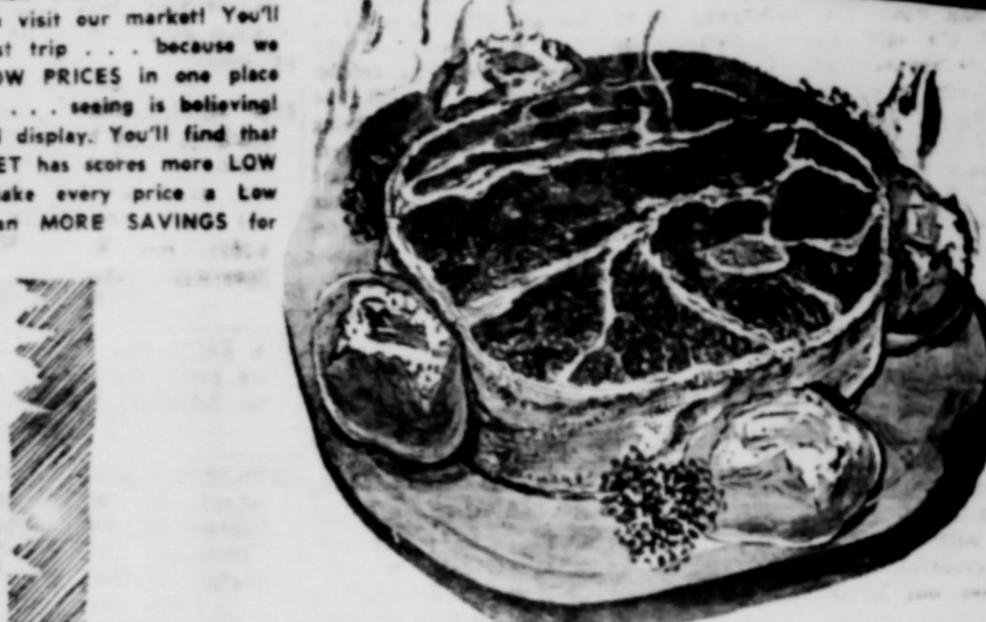

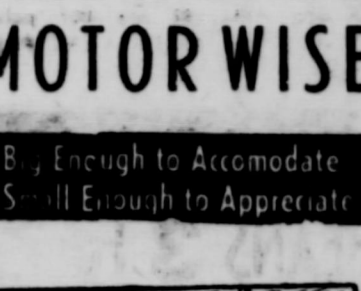
