far the greater numfar the greater num-
ber of these doaths and injuries were suffered by childies from five to fourteen years of age.
As we said bofare, parents must assume the major responsibility for the safety of their childrea. Parents mast see that thoir young rider where blejciling is goio we thexy miget helo gole conditicn; then safe conditicn; then
must prexnote a friendiv and cooperative enforcement offictrs; they must held the child develop an understanding of thpurpose of traffic gulations.
Here are some important rules to help your child work out for safe bike routes to and from school, o any other place he
wight customarily rice rignt customaris ride roadways are subject to the same reguiation responsibility, and privileges as motor vehicle cirivers:
Moserve all tyarfic
regulations - rod and regulations - rod and green lights, oae way streets, stop signs. Loep to the jizht rice single lis. behind ell vehtan: Have a headllisht on front and a danger light on the rear of jour bicycle. Wear white or light-colorod cloting, if you ever ride at night. (Many cities, including Epearman, prohibit night bicycilng!) Have a bell or horm to warm of approsch. speed. Cive pedestrians right of way. Aroid sidewaiks, is possible; use extra care when riding on walks!

puiling out inte traffic. leop sharp lookopening of car doors Ride in a straight line. Do not weave in or out of trifific or sherve fram side. to side.
