Mr. A. was a successful young business and Civic leader. His life was miserable from morning until night. He went to his doctor who soon found his problem beyond the reach of medicine or surgery. The minister explained that those calling upon God in faith are forgiven, and that when God forgives, he takes away sin, removes it, and it is not there any more.

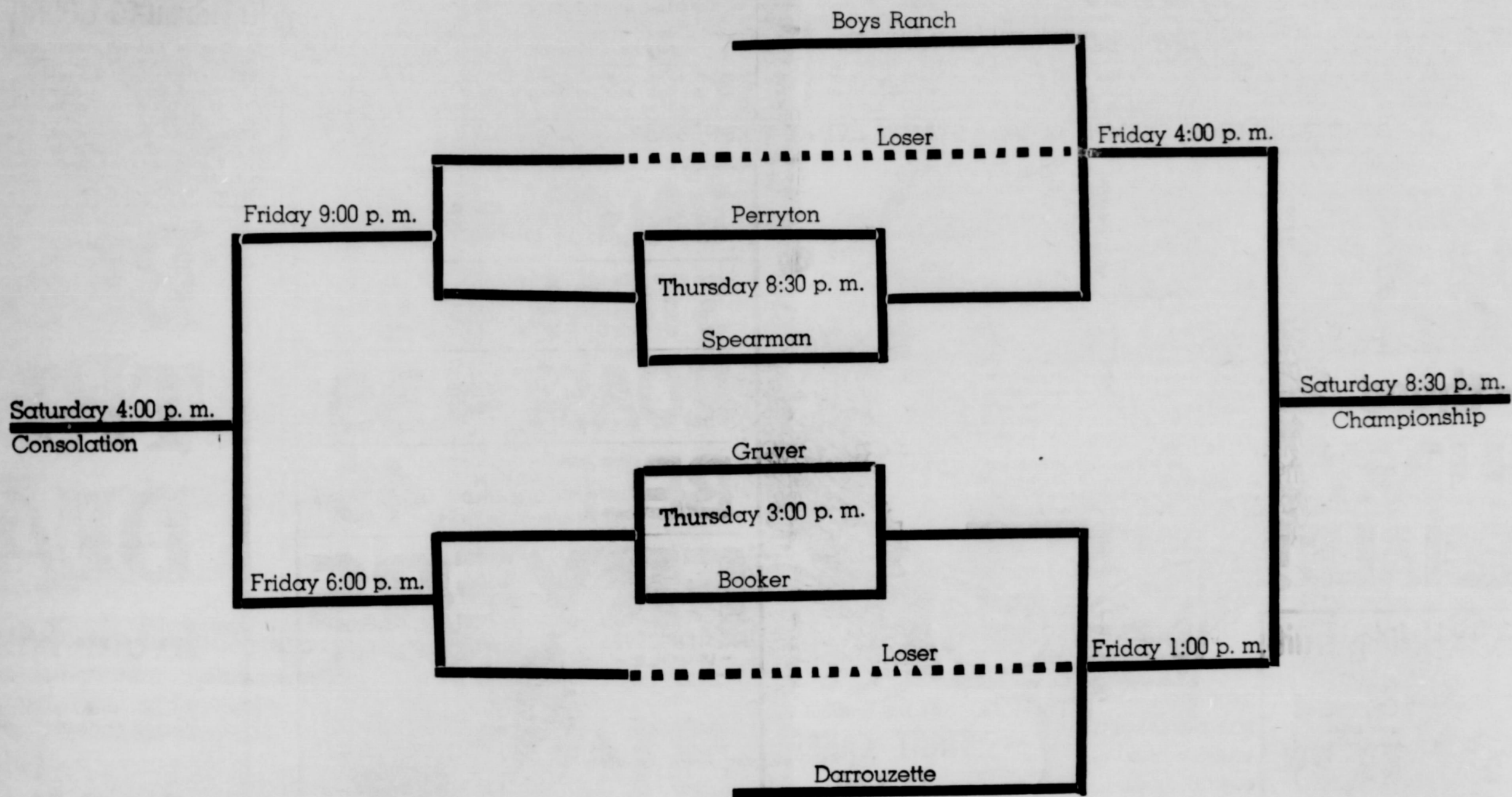

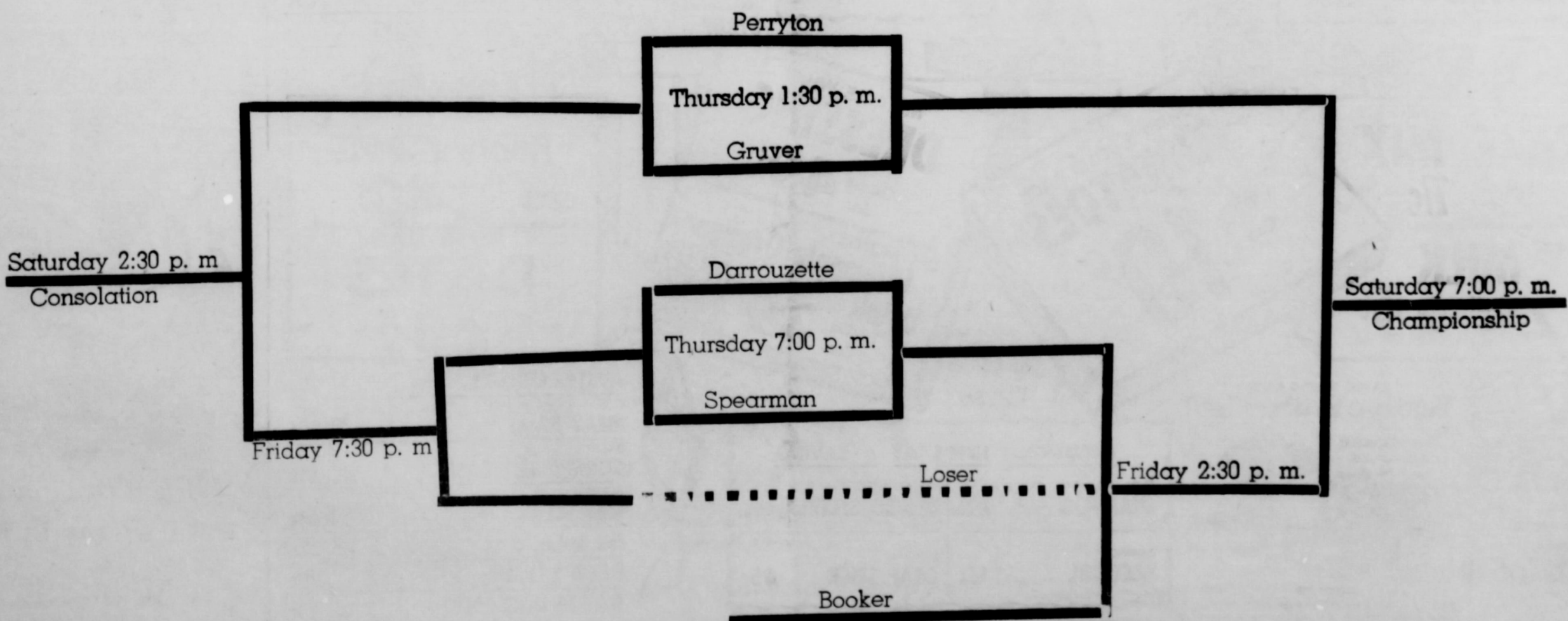
