Scripture Lesson:—Gen. 18:17

1. And Jehovah said, Shall I from Abraham that which I

Golden Text:—The Supplication Of A Righteous Man Availeth Much In Its Working.—James 5:16.

Introduction

The opening part of this chapter presents one of the most beautiful pictures of the charm of Oriental life to be found in all the Bible, and the last part of the chapter gives us a record of one of the greatest hours of fellowship between God and man found in the Old Testament. The chapter is so simply written and a revelation of such precious truths that every teacher will find it a joy to uncover to his or her pupils the riches of these verses. Hospitality is one of the essential characteristics of wilderness life, and in the customs and manners of the Bedouin Arabs of today there is reflected the dignified and open handed courtesy of the ancient patriarchs. Hospitality being the first of all duties every tent is ready for the stranger. Indeed all are willing to help and often vie with each other in their endeavors to supply the needs of the stranger who is called 'thai-fallah' 'the guest of God.'

The Three Guests of Abraham Gen. 18:2.

"Who were these three people, the guests of Abraham this day? In verse 2, they are spoken of as "three men" and in v. 16 and 22 as "the men." However in vs. 13, 17, 20 and 26 when one of the three speaks the phrase is used and Jehovah said, thereby definitely identifying the three as "the guests of God" (2 Chron. 29:7; Isa. 41:8; James 2:32), and is the only one left off communing with Abraham."

Abraham "The Friend of God" James 2:23.

Abraham is three times in the Bible spoken of as "the friend of God" and among all the characters of the Old Testament, "Abraham none other than the Lord Jesus Christ himself. After two of the identifying one of these men as the second Person of the Trinity men had parted we read in verse 22 that Abraham stood yet before Jehovah," and, in the last verse of the chapter we read, "Jehovah went his way," as soon as he had wickedness which characterized the life of the cities in the plain, including the city of Sodom, where his nephew Lot was residing with his family and as he saw these guests look toward this center of wickedness may it not be that in his own heart, he had a premonition that the wrath of God must sooner or later be poured out upon this place? Apparently he was reluctant to separate from his guests and that he might be with them as long as possible, he accompanied them for some distance as they journeyed on their way. Some men are glad when holy men depart from them; others enjoy the presence of God's servants and are lonely when they have left."

"And Jehovah said, Shall I hideK from Abraham that which

I do v. 17. God always knows what he is going to do in every circumstance concerning every individual and every nation. Often by prayer and abiding in the will of God we come to know God's specific purposes for us at specific times, as we face certain circumstances.

Abraham's Intercession For Sodom. Gen. 18:22-33.

"And the men turned from thence, and went toward Sodom; but Abraham stood yet before Jehovah. v. 22. "This prayer of Abraham arose from Abraham's knowledge of God's purposes toward Sodom and from Abraham's own love for Lot, and his feeling of deep responsibility for the son of his deceased brother, with whom for so many years he had lived and labored. Furthermore Abraham knew God. He had absolute confidence in God as one who heard prayer. Nothing but an expression of compassion and mercy on the part of God could have emboldened Abraham to speak as he did—to plead so earnestly for a place concerning which God has said 'Its cry is great and its sin is very grievous,'—and to persevere, moreover, in his plea, and carry it to such a length as to fear in, not with awe, but with confidence in reading it,—Robert Gordon.

"As it was only by obedience and righteousness that Abraham and his seed were to continue in God's favor, it was fair that they should be encouraged to do so by seeing the fruits of unrighteousness. So that as the Dead Sea lay throughout their whole history on their borders, reminding them of the wages of sin they might never fail rightly to interpret its meaning and in every great catastrophe read the lesson 'Except ye repent ye shall all likewise perish.' They could never attribute to chance this predicted judgment."— Marcus Dods.

SIDE LIGHTS

The special five million dollar provision for the Dust Bowl has been approved by the House of Representatives, and has gone to the Senate for action there. Of course, if the Senate declines to approve the appropriation, the money will not be available. However, see no reason why the Senate should not take favorable action.

I hope it will be possible for this step to be taken and for final approval to be obtained in the near future in order that work can get under way to combat the dust storms and their effects.

This is a special program which will be supplemental to the regular soil conservation set-up. It is intended to help farmers curtail the blowing of dust this season and next by means of allowances for various types of special erosion control practices.

Several of us have been working on this matter for some time,

and we are very glad to get it this far on the way.

In a recent message to Congress the President placed emphasis on the necessity of following a very careful course in government expenditures.

Now that the depression is behind us, the great burden of immediate emergency relief is lessened. The problem now is to taper off expenditures and bring them within the government's income.

I am in full accord with the move to economize on public expenditures. No government can last which persists indefinitely in spending more than it makes.

Many of the temporary activities can be curtailed. Some of the regular department activities will be able to get along on less.

However, I feel that the urgent need in the Great Plains area justifies an allotment of funds which will—taking a broad, long-time view of the situation—be in the interest of national economy.

Soil conservation in our section is an important part of the general agricultural program and that program must go forward.

So long as we have a tariff system, we must have an effective program for the farmer and ranchman to bring industry and agriculture more into balance.

In the past several years we have been engaged in obtaining this balance, and we must not loose our hold on the things we have already gained as a result of the improvements with which we are all familiar.

The knife that does the economy paring can cut away much excess, but we cannot allow it to slip and injure such a vital feature of this administration's work.

What can be grown in the garden is often asked?

A good variety should be grown in every plot. There should be a sufficient supply of leafy vegetables such as spinach, lettuce, cabbage, chard, etc. The garden should contain carrots, onions, turnips, beans, beets, squash, tomatoes, radishes, cucumbers, etc. Perennials such as asparagus, and rhubarb are excellent things to have in every garden. Wherever possible we should have a variety of berries.

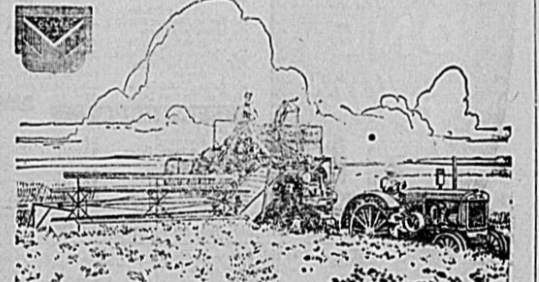
