## School Taxes Due!

Taxes for 1939 in the Spearman Independent School District are due and must be paid before Feb. 1st, 1940, to escape the burden of additional penalties and interest charges.

DELINQUENT PENALTIES-Payment of your taxes before Feb. 1, 1940 will avoid all penalty and interest charges. REMEMBER the penalties of 1939 unpaid taxes are added at the rate of 1 'percent per month until Jly 1, 1940, when the penalty is increased to 8 pecent and interest charges at the rate of $1 / 2$ percent per month are added.
