Higher Speeds?
There have been suggestions from a government-
industry panel that some vehicles be allowed to industry panel haat some vehicles be allowed to exceed which can attain 35 miles per gallon, or better, be allowed to operate at a greater speed.
The idea is to encourage motorists to buy cars with high mileage capability; these high-mileage cars would
be given special fluorescent plates. The panel would be given special fluorescent plates. The panel would
also slow the speed of heavy trucks and allow buses to travel at $70 \mathrm{~m} . \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{h}$. Rail traffic, highly efficient by energy consumption standards, should also be increasingly utilized.
Whether one

"fire" was not as lucrative as "conflagration". etc. The average reporter covered from ten to fifteen stories a day.
