Summer weather is generally thought not to be angerous and many assume thunderstoms are mostly noise and fury, without danger. However, lightning

avoid electrical equipment, the telephone and avoid electrical

If outdoors, one should stop work on metal fences, leave tractors, especially those pulling metal implements, stay away from tall trees, poles and solitary
fixtures and seek shelter in low areas away from water or in buildings.
